Specific responsibilities of the position include:

- To ensure NCSA transitional housing needs are met and maintained with up-to-date current building standards.
- To work on repairs for the general building on a ongoing basis to ensure this meets government standards.
- To monitor and check for safety concerns, inventory control and repairs in a timely manner.

Our ideal candidate would have the following qualifications:

- **In-depth experience and working knowledge of Indigenous communities, cultures, healing and language.**
- Demonstrated understanding of historic trauma and the impact of colonization on Indigenous people.
- Must have extensive previous experience and working knowledge pertaining to building maintenance.
- Physically fit to stand for long periods of time, doing routine manual work. Must be able to do work both indoors and outdoors with the various weather situations.
- Must adhere to government safety regulations and wear safety gear while working such as hard hats, goggles, work gloves, safety boots etc.
- Able to work efficiently as part of the team as well as work alone with superior interpersonal, communication, time management and documentation skills.
- Should be self motivated and able to work with minimum supervision with excellent time management skills.
- Must be customer focused with the ability to prioritize work on a day-to-day basis, maintain strict confidentiality.
- To understand NCSA Resiliency Model and required to incorporate it into daily practice with co-workers, management, clients and the community.
- Good working knowledge and experience using computers and information technology.
- Must have a reliable vehicle, valid Alberta driver's license with confirmation of vehicle insurance to use your vehicle as part of your employment.
- Must provide current criminal record check, child intervention checks upon hire.
