- Demonstrated understanding of historic trauma and the impact of colonization on Indigenous people.
- Ability seek out and build relationships with service providers and community members.
- Good understanding of the operation of service systems such as child and family services, justice, housing, income support and community services.
- Experience hiring and supporting staff, following contractual and NCSA guidelines and expectations.
- Strong interpersonal relations, conflict management, leadership and time management skills. Strong organizational and administrative skills with effective oral and written communication.
- Proficient knowledge of working with data base, Microsoft 365 and smart phone technology.
- Maybe required, willing to participate in cultural and land-based teachings.
- Must have a reliable vehicle, valid Alberta driver's license with required liability insurance and confirmation of insurance coverage to use your vehicle for work and/or to transport clients.
