Innovation & Originality	How creative or unique is the Al application used? Does it demonstrate new thinking, novel use of Al, or adaptation of existing tools in a transformative way?
Challenges, Objectives & Outcomes	What specific challenges did the Al address (e.g., safety, efficiency, design optimisation, sustainability, cost control)? Were the objectives clearly defined? How were challenges overcome?
Implementation	How effectively ha the Al been integrated into existing processes or systems? Provide evidence of teamwork across disciplines (e.g., engineers, IT, site managers, data scientists) and training, change management, and user adoption efforts.
Impact & Measurable Results	Provide evidence of tangible outcomes: cost savings, time reductions, improved accuracy, safety enhancements, sustainability benefits. Use of performance data, benchmarks, or KPIs
Industry & End User Benefit	Show evidence of Al contribution to advancing construction practices in Ireland. Show benefits to clients, communities, or end-users. Testimonials, case studies, visuals, user feedback, dashboards, or before/after comparisons

Essential tips for a successful entry

A successful application **must** address all the points above.

Marks will be allocated only on the evidence you provide.

Don't underestimate the power of presentation! You can use bullet points, charts, photographs, and client feedback in your submission. The more impressive your application appears and the stronger your evidence, the more it will support your case with the judges.

Please make sure you have included your Client References where applicable.

Make sure to include information on your exceptional successes during the year such as business systems, innovations or techniques that have reaped significant benefits.

Remember your document should be no more than 2500 words.

DO NOT include company marketing brochures in your entry.
