Summary	In no more than 250 words summarise why your company/ project deserves to win this award and why the project is significant in a heritage/conservation context.
Project Outline	Please provide a brief description of the project including the overall contract value, heritage status, dates of commencement and completion. The project scale and delivery model (design-build, PPP, modular)?
Design Features	Describe any innovative design features of this project and highlight what consideration was taken into how this project would sit physically within its environment and setting, highlight any sympathetic design principles used. Was accessibility & inclusivity taken into consideration?
Innovative use of Materials and Equipment	Highlight any innovative materials, circular economoy approaches or methods used while working on this development.
Health & Safety	Outline Health and Safety initiatives in place during the project (include evidence if available). Were there special measures for working on fragile/historic structures?
Fire Safety Compliance Evidence	Highlight how this project meets all relevant fire safety requirements or even goes that bit further than standard requirements.
Sustainability	Summarise the approach to sustainability that was adopted on this project. Energy efficiency improvements, use of renewables, reduction in emissions etc.
Impact on the Community or End Users	Outline how the completion of this project will enhance the lives of those who live in or in the locality of the development.
Supporting Statements & Testimonials	Include testimonials, case studies, client endorsements, charts, photos, or other documentation that strengthen your submission. Data, case studies, performance metrics should be included to show tangible value beyond typical methods.

## Essential tips for a successful entry

A successful application **must** address all the points above.

Project must be completed within the last 18 months.

Marks will be allocated only on the evidence you provide.

Don't underestimate the power of presentation! You can use bullet points, charts, photographs, and client feedback in your submission. The more impressive your application appears and the stronger your evidence, the more it will support your case with the judges.

Please make sure you have included your Client References where applicable.

Make sure to include information on your exceptional successes during the year such as business systems, innovations or techniques that have reaped significant benefits.

Remember your document should be no more than 2500 words.

**DO NOT** include company marketing brochures in your entry.
