What to Bring to the Message Retreat

1. Paper Bibles
 - **Note** - All Students are prohibited from bringing any and all electronics.
2. Flashlight
 - Please bring a Flashlight for traveling at Night Time.
3. Warm Clothes
 - Jacket, Shirts, Socks, Sweater, Pants, etc.
 - **Note** - *Any students seen wearing inappropriate clothing will be asked to change.*
4. Toiletries
 - Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Shampoo, Lotion, Soap, Towels, etc.
5. Reusable Water Bottles
6. Linen, Blankets, Pillows, or Sleeping Bags

What NOT to Bring to the Message Retreat

1. Electronics
 - Phones, iPads/Tablets, Electronic Watches (ex. Apple, Samsung Watches) Laptops, Game consoles, etc
 - **Note** - Each church will be responsible for collecting ALL of each student's electronics before you arrive at the retreat center.
 - We advise that you collect your student's cell phones, and ensure your students turn off all alarms that may go off during the Message Retreat.
2. Inappropriate Clothing
 - Clothing that is revealing (i.e. muscle shirts, crop tops, short-shorts, etc.)
 - Clothing that expresses, suggests, or displays any of the following is **prohibited**: violence, weapons, drugs, alcohol, profanity, sexually explicit content, and hate.
3. Games of any kind (Cards, Electronics, Board Games)
 - These include games like Monopoly Deal, Playing Cards, Nintendo Switches., etc)
4. Drugs of any kind unless they have been prescribed by their primary doctor.
 - **Note** - Any drugs, both legal and illegal, unless prescribed should **NOT** be brought. This includes cigarettes, e-cigarettes/vape, over-the-counter drugs (ex. advil), etc.
 - Any students in need of over-the-counter medications will be provided by their respective pastors and staff through the Admin station of the Message Retreat.

Note - Please be aware that students and parents signing the registration form have granted pastors, Message Retreat leaders, and staff the power to confiscate any prohibited items that are seen.
