- You must be 18 years of age
- You must have a Valid Government Issued
 Photo ID and Social Security Number
- You must be physically fit to work in this industry and pass our Apprentice Entry Assessment, also known as "Bootcamp."
- AEA/Bootcamp is a 5-day process

Day 1: Drug Test and Enrollment Paperwork

Day 2-4: Physical Agility Test

Day 5: Oral Interview

Completing the OJT and RSI requirements will help you move up the wage scale and earn MORE money!

OJT ON-THE-JOB TRAINING

For each period you move up, you will work 600-700 hours of On-The-Job Training (OJT) alongside your classroom instruction. By the end of the program you will have collected 4,000 hours of work!

RSI RELATED SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTION

For every 600-700 hours of OJT you must complete 50 hours of RSI for your upgrade!
