

Welcome, Friends!

Welcome to our Northern New England Conference camp meeting! We are so glad you are here and can't wait to see how The Holy Spirit is going to bless and empower you!

Did you know Jesus could have returned sometime before 1898? Notice the following quote and the date when it was published.

"Had the church of Christ done her appointed work as the Lord ordained, the whole world would before this been warned, and The Lord Jesus would have come to our earth in great power and great glory" (Mountain View, CA: Pacific Press Publishing Association, 1898).

So, what happened? Apparently, the Seventh-day Adventist Church did not do "her appointed work." The work of proclaiming the Three Angel's Messages found in Revelation 14:6-12.

"In a special sense Seventh day Adventist have been set in the world as watchmen and light bearers. To them has been entrusted the last warning for a perishing world. There is no other work of so great importance. They are to allow nothing else to absorb their attention" (Testimonies to the Church vol 9, p. 19).

Even if we didn't have the gift of prophesy, we could still know that a faithful proclamation of the Three Angel's Messages is a prerequisite for the coming of Christ, since Revelation 14:14 describes the glorious return of Jesus directly after the Three Angel's messages are proclaimed!

"And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle" (Revelation 14:14).

This is why our theme for camp meeting this year is "It's 3 AM! God's Last Message of Hope".

In other words, it's time to proclaim the Three Angel's Messages (3AM) in the power of the Holy Spirit! It's time to share God's final message of hope throughout Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont and the world!


