Stonebridge Golf Club Course Rules

Please find below our course rules, dress code, timings and access rules. If anyone is found not adhering to these rules you may be asked to leave the course.

- No play on the course is allowed before <u>7:00am</u>. The greenkeepers have essential works to be carried before this time to ensure the golf course is presented in good condition.
- Play 'Ready Golf'. Play when ready even if it isn't 'your turn' to play.
- If a player feels their ball is either lost or may be out of bounds, a provisional ball must be played.
- If you have fallen behind the group in front, call the group behind you through.
- Repair pitch marks, replace divots and rake bunkers after use! If anyone is found damaging the course this will result in removal from the course and a ban for future play.
- Any form of discrimination, harassment or intimidation to other players or staff is regarded as unacceptable behaviour and you will be asked to leave the course.
- If you are using a buggy do not drive over tee boxes and park no closer than 5 yards away from all green surfaces.
- No dogs are permitted on the golf course except for assistance dogs.
- No bag sharing. Each player must use their own bag and clubs.
- A non-golfer is permitted on the course only when accompanying a playing golfer. This can be by way of a caddy or parent offering supervision to a junior. A plus 1 not covered above may be allowed, providing the Pro Shop is informed and it is deemed safe to do so.
- Any non-golfer on the course found to be using clubs will be deemed as a player and will be asked to
 pay a green fee. The player will be held responsible for their non golfer and any damage or interference
 they may cause.

Course Dress Code

At Stonebridge we have a 'relaxed and welcoming' dress code. All golf themed attire is classed as acceptable.

The following items are not allowed to be worn on the golf course:-

- > denim clothing
- cargo/combat trousers
- football or beach shorts
- > tracksuits
- > any sports shirts/tops and gym attire.

We do ask that golf shoes are worn on the golf course where possible. We consider golf shoes to be any shoe specifically designed for golfing use. Flat soled 'golf themed' trainers are acceptable.

All boots unless golf specific, trainers and flip flops are <u>not</u> permitted.

Please be aware our Golf Team and Marshalls reserve the right to refuse access to the course if our dress code is not adhered to.

Course Timings and Access

When booking your golf at Stonebridge you are automatically allocated a back 9 tee time. Your time is allocated as follows:

- When playing the Hampton your back 9 time is 2 hours after your start time.
- When playing the Blythe your back 9 time is 2 hours 8 minutes after your start time.
- When playing the Somers your back 9 time is 2 hours 8 minutes after your start time.

If these times are not kept to, the following rules apply:

- If you arrive early for your back 9 then priority is given to those with a booked tee time for their front 9. Playing your back 9 will not give you priority over those with a front 9 time that is booked on the tee sheet.
- The tee sheet is designed to take into account varying conditions and situations to allow yours and other group's golf to run smoothly. If you try to push in on the back 9 you are potentially slowing play down for yourselves and other course users.
- If you arrive for your back 9 early you can check with the golf team if there is a free slot before your official back 9 time. If not, you are required to stick to your back 9 time.
- If you are late for your back 9 time and the tee is not available, please report to the golf team.
- If you have any issues on the tee, please contact the golf team.
