CHARACTER BREAKDOWN

REVEREND SHAW MOORE: *Male, 35-55. Baritone.*

The powerful, traditional local church leader; strict, stern, and solemn, still struggling with the death of his son. He has problems communicating with his daughter Ariel, he still loves her very much but has problems expressing it. Strong actor, singer and mover.

VI MOORE: *Female, 30-50. Soprano.*

Reverend Moore's loving, supportive, resilient wife. Strong actor, singer and mover.

ETHEL MCCORMACK: *Female, 35-45. Alto.*

Ren's mother tries her best to stay strong for her son after the unexpected departure of her husband. She does occasionally let her emotions shine through. Strong singer, actor and mover.
