

There were no casualties. Neither the Master nor the pleasure craft operator followed COLREGs guidelines for limited visibility weather. Read the full

• Sweden - On 4th October 2024, there was a near-collision between the passenger vessels 'Eskil' and 'Baltic Princess' in Stockholm, Sweden. There were no casualties, and the cause for the accident was deemed to be the high workload the Master was under, which distracted him from conducting a proper lookout. Read the full report
