Reflecting on Today's Readings

Jesus says, "Do not be afraid any longer, little flock, for the Father is pleased to give you the kingdom. Sell your belongings and give alms." "Where your treasure is, there also will your heart be." So, we might ask ourselves, "What is it that I treasure above all else?" "Is my heart in the right place?" "Why am I afraid?" And when we see how much God has blessed us, He has the right to demand much from us in return for all that He has entrusted to us. We might also ask ourselves if we really do have faith in God. Abraham had so much faith that he was willing to sacrifice his only son, Isaac, if that is what God wanted. Are we willing to part with some of the abundance that God has poured out on us, trusting that God will use our sacrifice to build up His kingdom? Is that where our treasure lies? Or does our treasure lie in our holding on to everything that we can get our hands on? Someday, whether we are ready or not, our time will be up; our Lord will call us to come to Him. Will we want to celebrate, or will we be terrified? Being people of faith, we want to be grateful to God for all His gifts, and to look forward to Heaven. But we are also fearful of death. But since we have the Gospels, and we know of the Resurrection, we should listen to the words of Jesus even more closely: "Do not be afraid any longer, little flock, for the Father is pleased to give you the kingdom." We want to treasure that day and cherish that hope in eternal life. We want our heart to be set on those blessings that will endure forever, and which will bring us perfect joy in the company of all the saints.

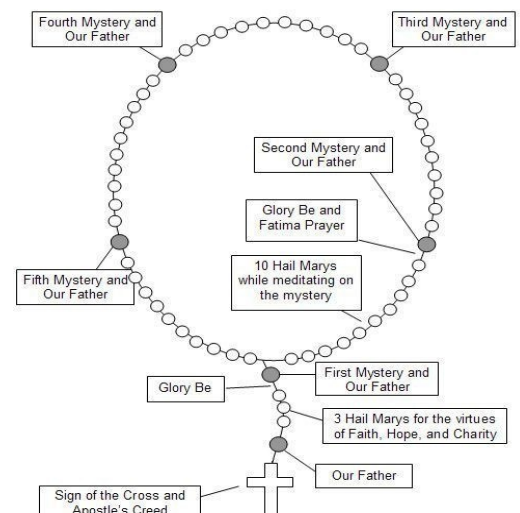
