Some Things Are So Simple

Naaman, the leper from Syria, at first refuses to follow the Prophet Elisha's advice: (wash seven times in the Jordan River). It's too simple a thing to do. Naaman, at first, does not believe that bathing in the Jordan will help him. But when he finally does what Elisha told him to do, and simply bathes in the waters, he is healed of leprosy! God tells us, through the Church, to do simple things too. We are told to simply come together for Mass on the Lord's Day. Be Baptized (a simple ceremony), and pass the faith on to your children. Come to the Sacraments and be fed and healed spiritually and physically. "Come to me, all you who are thirsty," says Jesus, "and I will give you to drink of life-giving water." It's all so simple. Yet many, like Naaman, refuse to follow the advice that will save their lives and lead them to eternal life. The spiritual fulfillment and the fullness of God's revelation that all people are said to be searching for, in truth, subsists in the Catholic Church. The living waters flow abundantly through the Sacraments, but many people refuse to come, which is a tragedy. They may be willing to do difficult tasks, to climb a great mountain in search of fulfillment, when it's simply waiting there for them at any Mass. For centuries, people were waiting for a great Messiah to come and save them, yet they missed Him when He came as a baby, born in Bethlehem on Christmas day. So let us not miss what is always before us in the Church that Jesus founded, where we can be guided safely and surely toward eternal life. As Naaman wanted to be cleansed of leprosy, we want to be cleansed from sin. Instead of washing in the Jordan River, we can simply go to Confession!

Algunas Cosas Son Tan Sencillas

Naamán, el leproso de Siria, al principio se niega a seguir el consejo del profeta Eliseo: (lavarse siete veces en el río Jordán). Es algo demasiado simple de hacer. Naamán, al principio, no cree que bañarse en el Jordán lo ayudará. Pero cuando finalmente hace lo que Eliseo le dijo que hiciera, y simplemente se baña en las aguas, ¡se cura de la lepra! Dios nos dice, a través de la Iglesia, que también hagamos cosas sencillas. Se nos dice que simplemente nos reunamos para la Misa el Día del Señor. Ser bautizados (una ceremonia sencilla) y transmitir la fe a nuestros hijos. Venir a los sacramentos y ser alimentados y sanados espiritual y físicamente. "Venid a mí todos los que tenéis sed," dice Jesús, "y yo os daré a beber del agua que da vida." Todo es tan sencillo. Sin embargo, muchos, como Naamán, se niegan a seguir el consejo que salvará sus vidas y los llevará a la vida eterna. El cumplimiento espiritual y la plenitud de la revelación de Dios que se dice que todos los hombres buscan, en verdad, subsiste en la Iglesia Católica. Las aguas vivas fluyen abundantemente a través de los Sacramentos, pero muchas personas se niegan a venir, lo cual es una tragedia. Pueden estar dispuestos a hacer tareas difíciles, a escalar una gran montaña en busca de satisfacción, cuando simplemente está esperándolos allí en cualquier Misa. Durante siglos, la gente estuvo esperando que viniera un gran Mesías y los salvara, pero lo perdieron cuando vino como un bebé, nacido en Belén el día de Navidad. Así que no perdamos lo que siempre está ante nosotros en la Iglesia que Jesús fundó, donde podemos ser guiados de manera segura y segura hacia la vida eterna. Como Naamán quería ser limpiado de la lepra, queremos ser limpiados del pecado. En lugar del río Jordán, podemos ir a confesarnos.
