A Reflection for All Souls Day

In November, the Church prays for "All Souls" who have died and are being prepared for Heaven. Many of us have had to say "goodbye" to loved ones who have died during the past year. And God wants us to make an act of faith, just as Martha and Mary did when their brother Lazarus had died. They trusted Jesus, and He called Lazarus back to life! Through the prophet Isaiah, God says that he will destroy death forever, and wipe away the tears from all faces. The healing of the world's ancient wound—death, which infected creation by the first sin of Adam and Eve—has already been healed! On the cross, Jesus conquered death! The remedy has been applied. But we still experience pain and suffering even as we know that Heaven is close to us. Just as when we've been injured and have a wound, we apply the medicine and a bandage—and we know that all will be well—but we still feel the throbbing because healing takes time. St. Paul says that, "If ...we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him." Jesus says that God's will is that every one of us should be raised up on the last day. God loves everyone infinitely more than we possibly could, even people who don't seem very holy. We pray for all the souls being prepared for Heaven, entrusting them to God, knowing that He will take good care of them. At every Mass, we deepen our communion with them when we join in the heavenly banquet of the Body and Blood of Christ. Even if we suffer heartbreak because we live in time, not yet in eternity, we know that all will be well. In God's time, all of our tears will be wiped away. We pray that God will bring all of us home to our destination in Heaven.

Reflexión para el Día de los Fieles Difuntos

En noviembre, la Iglesia ora por los “fieles difuntos” que han fallecido y se están preparando para el Cielo. Muchos de nosotros hemos tenido que despedirnos de seres queridos que han fallecido durante el último año. Y Dios quiere que hagamos un acto de fe, tal como lo hicieron Marta y María cuando murió su hermano Lázaro. Confiaron en Jesús, ¡y Él resucitó a Lázaro! A través del profeta Isaías, Dios dice que destruirá la muerte para siempre, y enjugará las lágrimas de todos los rostros. ¡La sanación de la antigua herida del mundo —la muerte, que infectó la creación por el primer pecado de Adán y Eva— ya ha sido sanada! En la cruz, Jesús conquistó la muerte. El remedio ha sido aplicado. Pero aún experimentamos dolor y sufrimiento aun cuando sabemos que el Cielo está cerca de nosotros. Así como cuando nos lesionamos y tenemos una herida, aplicamos la medicina y una venda, y sabemos que todo estará bien, pero todavía sentimos el pulsación porque la curación lleva tiempo. San Pablo dice que, “Si... hemos muerto con Cristo, creemos que también viviremos con él.” Jesús dice que la voluntad de Dios es que cada uno de nosotros resucite en el último día. Dios ama a todos infinitamente más de lo que podríamos amar, incluso a las personas que no parecen muy santas. Oramos por todas las almas que se preparan para el Cielo, confiándolas a Dios, sabiendo que Él cuidará bien de ellas. En cada Misa, profundizamos nuestra comunión con ellas cuando nos unimos al banquete celestial del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Incluso si sufrimos angustia porque vivimos en el tiempo, aún no en la eternidad, sabemos que todo estará bien. En el tiempo de Dios, todas nuestras lágrimas serán enjugadas. Oramos para que Dios nos lleve a todos a casa a nuestro destino en el Cielo.
