The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome

The Emperor Constantine granted liberty to Christians in 313, and numerous churches were constructed. Constantine himself also constructed churches, one of which was a magnificent basilica on the Caelian Hill in Rome, over the ancient Lateran Palace. The name of this Papal Basilica is the Basilica of the Most Holy Savior and of Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist in the Lateran. Christians consider the Basilica to be the mother church of all churches in the world. It has been destroyed and rebuilt several times. The present basilica was rededicated in 1724. The biblical readings for today's feast develop the theme of a “temple”. Around 592 BC, the prophet Ezekiel encouraged the people in exile by announcing a day on which the people would adore God in a new temple. The temple would assume the role as the House of God. Ezekiel prophesies: “I saw water flowing out from beneath the threshold of the temple”. This water was a gift, a blessing, that brought life wherever it flowed. It was a place in which justice was exercised. Our Gospel shows Jesus purifying the Temple by driving out the merchants and money-changers: “Take these out of here, and stop making my Father's house a marketplace.” These words and actions bring to mind the prophet Zechariah who prophesied what would happen when the Lord would come into the city of Jerusalem: “On that day...there shall no longer be a trader in the house of the Lord” (Zc 14:21). Jesus said: “Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up.” “He was speaking about the temple of his Body.” We are reminded today that each one of us is a “house of God” in the Risen Jesus, because the Holy Spirit dwells in each one of us.

La Dedicación de la Basílica de Letrán en Roma

El emperador Constantino concedió la libertad a los cristianos en el año 313, y se construyeron numerosas iglesias. El propio Constantino también mandó construir iglesias, entre ellas una magnífica basílica en la colina Celio de Roma, sobre el antiguo Palacio de Letrán. El nombre de esta basílica papal es Basílica del Santísimo Salvador y de los Santos Juan Bautista y Juan Evangelista en Letrán. Los cristianos consideran la basílica la iglesia madre de todas las iglesias del mundo. Ha sido destruida y reconstruida varias veces. La basílica actual fue reinaugurada en 1724. Las lecturas bíblicas para la fiesta de hoy desarrollan el tema del "templo". Alrededor del año 592 a. C., el profeta Ezequiel animó al pueblo exiliado anunciando el día en que adorarían a Dios en un nuevo templo. El templo asumiría el papel de Casa de Dios. Ezequiel profetiza: "Vi agua que brotaba de debajo del umbral del templo." Esta agua era un don, una bendición, que traía vida por dondequiera que fluía. Era un lugar donde se ejercía la justicia. Nuestro Evangelio muestra a Jesús purificando el Templo al expulsar a los mercaderes y cambistas. "Saquen esto de aquí y dejen de convertir la casa de mi Padre en un mercado." Estas palabras y acciones nos recuerdan al profeta Zacarías, quien profetizó lo que sucedería cuando el Señor entrara en Jerusalén: "En aquel día... no habrá más comerciantes en la casa del Señor" (Zac 14:21). Jesús dijo: "Destruyan este templo, y en tres días lo levantaré." "Se refería al templo de su Cuerpo." Hoy recordamos que cada uno de nosotros es una "casa de Dios" en Jesús resucitado, porque el Espíritu Santo mora en cada uno de nosotros.
