Epiphany is the Time of Fulfillment

Today, the prophetic words of the Prophet Isaiah are fulfilled: “Rise up in splendor, Jerusalem! Your light has come, the glory of the Lord shines upon you. ... Nations shall walk by your light, and kings by your shining radiance. ... for the riches of the sea shall be emptied out before you, the wealth of nations shall be brought to you. ... all from Sheba shall come bearing gold and frankincense, and proclaiming the praises of the LORD.”

The words of our Psalm are fulfilled: “Lord, every nation on earth will adore you. The kings of Tarshish and the Isles shall offer gifts; the kings of Arabia and Seba shall bring tribute. All kings shall pay him homage, all nations shall serve him.”

The words of Saint Paul to the Ephesians are fulfilled: “It was not made known to people in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit: that the Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body, and copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel.”

The Church celebrates the manifestation of God's glory to the Gentiles today, as the Wise Men arrive: “And behold, the star that they had seen at its rising preceded them, until it came and stopped over the place where the child was. They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.”

La Epifanía es el Tiempo del Cumplimiento

Hoy se cumplen las palabras proféticas del profeta Isaías: “¡Levántate, Jerusalén, resplandece! Tu luz ha llegado, la gloria del Señor brilla sobre ti. ... Las naciones caminarán a tu luz, y los reyes a tu radiante esplendor. ... Las riquezas del mar se derramarán ante ti, la riqueza de las naciones te será traída. ... Todos los de Saba vendrán trayendo oro e incienso, y proclamando las alabanzas del Señor.”

Se cumplen las palabras de nuestro Salmo: “Señor, todas las naciones de la tierra te adorarán. Los reyes de Tarsis y de las islas ofrecerán dones; los reyes de Arabia y de Saba traerán tributo. Todos los reyes le rendirán homenaje, todas las naciones le servirán.”

Se cumplen las palabras de San Pablo a los Efesios: “Este misterio no se dio a conocer a las generaciones anteriores, como ahora ha sido revelado a sus santos apóstoles y profetas por el Espíritu: que los gentiles son coherederos, miembros del mismo cuerpo y partícipes de la promesa en Cristo Jesús por medio del Evangelio.” La Iglesia celebra hoy la manifestación de la gloria de Dios a los gentiles con la llegada de los Reyes Magos: “Y he aquí que la estrella que habían visto en Oriente los precedía, hasta que se detuvo sobre el lugar donde estaba el niño. Al ver la estrella, se llenaron de gran alegría. Entraron en la casa y vieron al niño con María, su madre; se postraron y lo adoraron. Luego abrieron sus cofres y le ofrecieron regalos: oro, incienso y mirra.”

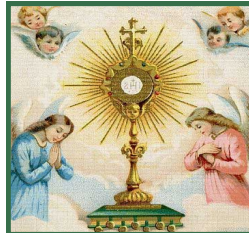
Church Candles
