Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph

The Holy Family is a model of the *perfect* family, in perfect unity. When Adam & Eve sinned, dis-unity and death entered the world. Jesus once began a conversation with a Samaritan woman at a well by asking her for a drink of water. Soon, he says, “Go, call your husband.” She replies, “I have no husband.” He reveals that he *knows* her; he knows that she has *suffered* a lot: She’s had *five* husbands, and is probably considered a “sinner” by the townsfolk. He doesn’t condemn her, but rather invites her to experience the love of God, and she runs to get the townsfolk to come and meet Jesus themselves! The result is that they *all* come to believe in Him. We have all suffered from “dis-unity”, and we see our world “falling apart” from anger and division! But the Holy Family shows us the love that God intends for us. No matter what we have suffered in our lives, we want to respond like the Samaritan woman at the well. Jesus told her that, if she knew who she was speaking with, she would have asked *him*, and he would have given her “*living water*”—the Holy Spirit. And as we meet the Holy Family today, we are drinking in the words of our Lord. We want to be members of the Holy Family, too. If we keep in touch with them in prayer, they will be forever helpful and supportive in all of our problems and anxieties, and in all our joys as well. They will help us, day or night, to be as holy a family as they are, as will the *rest* of the family, the entire Communion of Saints! Jesus said that whoever does the will of His heavenly Father is mother and sister and brother to Him. It’s heavenly to have such relatives as the Holy Family. This truly is our family!

Él le revela que la conoce; sabe que ha sufrido mucho: ha tenido cinco maridos, y probablemente es considerada una pecadora por la gente del pueblo. Él no la condena, sino que la invita a experimentar el amor de Dios, y ella corre a buscar a la gente del pueblo para que vengan a conocer a Jesús. Como resultado, todos creen en Él. Todos hemos sufrido la desunión, y vemos nuestro mundo desmoronarse a causa de la ira y la división. Pero la Sagrada Familia nos muestra el amor que Dios tiene para nosotros. Sin importar lo que hayamos sufrido en nuestras vidas, queremos responder como la mujer samaritana junto al pozo. Jesús le dijo que, si supiera con quién estaba hablando, le habría pedido, y él le habría dado "agua viva", el Espíritu Santo. Y al encontrarnos hoy con la Sagrada Familia, bebemos de las palabras de nuestro Señor. Nosotros también queremos ser miembros de la Sagrada Familia.
