3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

January 18 to 25 is the annual “Week of Prayer for Christian Unity”, and we remember that, before He died, Jesus prayed “that all may be one!” St. Paul urges the Corinthians to be united in the faith, not divided into factions and rivalries based on whoever baptized them, or first preached to them. Jesus founded only one Church: a universal, or Catholic, Church, for all people of all times. Sadly, there are divisions among Christians, arising from our weakness and sinfulness. Only the Holy Spirit can unite us and enable us to work harmoniously as members of the Body of Christ. We have to protect that unity of faith, and see to it that we come to know our faith as best we can. Today, with the many means of communication we have, with all the confusing contradictions surrounding us, we need to be extra vigilant that we read good Catholic books and articles, and listen to faithful commentary from those who are firm in their faith, because there is a very great danger that any of us could lose our faith if we don't practice it and guard it. Do we listen to people who love the Church? Or people who want to change the Church into something contrary to God's will? There are a lot of mis-led “evangelical-type” folks around who are trying especially hard to lead Catholics out of the Church. Sadly, they succeed in confusing many people and leading them into the dark. “The blind, leading the blind.” Jesus once asked, “When the Son of Man comes, will he find any faith on earth?” We should hope that the answer will be a loud “Yes!” but we must do our part to learn and live our Catholic faith, to be united in the Church, and not just be a member of one or another divisive faction.

Tercer Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Del 18 al 25 de enero se celebra la Semana de Oración por la Unidad de los Cristianos, y recordamos que, antes de morir, Jesús oró para que todos fueran uno. San Pablo exhorta a los corintios a estar unidos en la fe, no divididos en facciones y rivalidades basadas en quién los bautizó o quién les predicó primero. Jesús fundó una sola Iglesia: una Iglesia universal, o católica, para todas las personas de todos los tiempos. Lamentablemente, existen divisiones entre los cristianos, que surgen de nuestra debilidad y pecaminosidad. Solo el Espíritu Santo puede unirnos y permitirnos trabajar en armonía como miembros del Cuerpo de Cristo. Debemos proteger esa unidad de fe y asegurarnos de conocer nuestra fe lo mejor posible. Hoy, con los muchos medios de comunicación que tenemos y con todas las confusas contradicciones que nos rodean, necesitamos estar especialmente vigilantes para leer buenos libros y artículos católicos y escuchar comentarios fieles de quienes son firmes en su fe, porque existe un gran peligro de que cualquiera de nosotros pierda la fe si no la practica y la protege. ¿Escuchamos a personas que aman a la Iglesia? ¿O acaso se trata de personas que quieren transformar la Iglesia en algo contrario a la voluntad de Dios? Hay muchas personas mal informadas, de mentalidad supuestamente evangélica, que se esfuerzan especialmente por alejar a los católicos de la Iglesia. Lamentablemente, logran confundir a muchos, y conducirlos por el camino equivocado. Son como ciegos guiando a otros ciegos. Jesús preguntó una vez: "Cuando venga el Hijo del Hombre, ¿encontrará fe en la tierra?" Debemos esperar que la respuesta sea un rotundo "¡Sí!", pero debemos hacer nuestra parte para aprender y vivir nuestra fe católica, para estar unidos en la Iglesia y no ser simplemente miembros de una u otra facción que siembra la división.
