Blessed are the Merciful

Today we hear part of the Sermon on the Mount from the Gospel of Matthew. Jesus says that those who are poor in spirit, who are meek, who hunger and thirst for righteousness, and who are merciful will be blessed. Those who are insulted and persecuted because they follow Jesus will be blessed. Jesus is meek and merciful and hungers for righteousness. He accepted insults and persecution and offered it all to His Father in Heaven. And that is how He saved the world, conquered sin and death, and revealed the Resurrection to us. The way to Heaven is to be like Jesus, who said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." We should read the entire Sermon on the Mount; it begins with Chapter 5 in Matthew's Gospel, and Jesus gives us a lot more guidance for our lives: "You are the salt of the earth." "You are the light of the world. Let your light shine before others so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven." "I have come not to abolish, but to fulfill the law." He tells us about Anger, Adultery, Divorce. About Oaths: Let your "Yes" mean yes, and your "No" mean no." About Retaliation, he says, "Turn the other cheek." Love your Enemies. About Almsgiving: "When you give alms, do not let your left hand know what your right is doing, so that your almsgiving may be secret. And your Father who sees in secret will repay you." He teaches us to Pray the "Our Father", and tells us about Fasting, and Having our Treasure in Heaven, and Depending on God. If we follow His example, and are meek, humble, self-sacrificing, and clean of heart, we can hope to share in the blessedness of the saints.

Bienaventurados los Misericordiosos

Hoy escuchamos parte del Sermón de la Montaña del Evangelio de Mateo. Jesús dice que serán bienaventurados los pobres de espíritu, los mansos, los que tienen hambre y sed de justicia, y los misericordiosos. También serán bienaventurados quienes sean insultados y perseguidos por seguir a Jesús. Jesús es manso y misericordioso, y tiene hambre de justicia. Aceptó los insultos y la persecución, y lo ofreció todo a su Padre celestial. Y así fue como salvó al mundo, venció el pecado y la muerte, y nos reveló la Resurrección. El camino al Cielo es ser como Jesús, quien dijo: "Yo soy el camino, la verdad, y la vida. Nadie viene al Padre sino por mí". Deberíamos leer el Sermón de la Montaña completo; comienza en el capítulo 5 del Evangelio de Mateo, y Jesús nos da muchas más enseñanzas para nuestras vidas: "Ustedes son la sal de la tierra". "Ustedes son la luz del mundo. Que su luz brille ante los demás, para que vean sus buenas obras y glorifiquen a su Padre que está en el cielo". "No he venido a abolir la ley, sino a cumplirla." Nos habla de la ira, el adulterio, y el divorcio. Sobre los juramentos, dice: "Que tu "sí" sea sí, y tu "no" sea no". Sobre la venganza, dice: "Poned la otra mejilla". Amad a sus enemigos. Sobre la limosna: "Cuando des limosna, que tu mano izquierda no sepa lo que hace la derecha, para que tu limosna sea en secreto. Y tu Padre, que ve en lo secreto, te recompensará". Nos enseña a rezar el Padrenuestro y nos habla del ayuno, de tener nuestro tesoro en el cielo, y de confiar en Dios. Si seguimos su ejemplo y somos mansos, humildes, abnegados, y puros de corazón, podemos esperar compartir la bienaventuranza de los santos.

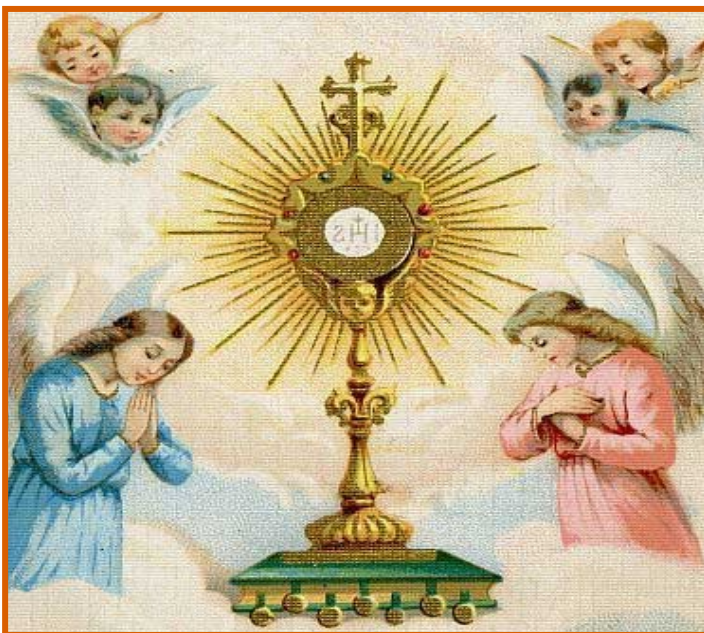

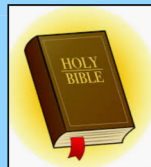
