If you share your bread with the hungry, and shelter the oppressed and the homeless, light shall shine for you in the darkness. You are the salt of the earth. You are the light of the world. If we have failed to live good Christian lives up until now, the story can still have a happy ending if we come to the realization that true joy will be found in living our faith by doing the things that God expects of us. If we will share our bread with the hungry, or shelter the needy, or bring light and joy to those in darkness, or extend forgiveness to an enemy, then it will be as if we are watching a movie where the main character becomes a holy, happy person whom we might joyfully applaud because he turns out to be a good person after all! As we hear the words that Jesus spoke in the Sermon on the Mount, we can humbly try to put His words into action. He will assist us. Any good deed that we do, even as small as a mustard seed, will grow into something Heavenly with the grace of God. Love covers a multitude of sins.

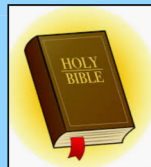
