Following the Way of Jesus

Jesus says, “Unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven.” His listeners might have wondered how they could ever hope to surpass the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees. But “righteousness” does not come from keeping the commandments. It comes from choosing to love as God has loved us. Jesus says, “You have heard that it was said...” and then He quotes some of the commandments, and continues with the words, “But I say to you...” and He tells us how to really be righteous. For example, “Thou shalt not kill” can be violated by being rude and insulting to another person, hitting them with angry words. Jesus teaches his listeners how to be truly “great” in the kingdom of heaven. “If you bring your gift to the altar, and there recall that your brother has anything against you, leave your gift there at the altar, go first and be reconciled with your brother, and then come and offer your gift.” Those who listen to Jesus and act according to his way of living, are in a better position for living righteously than the scribes and Pharisees who thought that keeping “the letter of the law” was enough. Our First Reading today, from Sirach, says, “Before man are life and death, good and evil, whichever he chooses shall be given him; to whichever you choose, stretch forth your hand.” Jesus tells us how to please God. We want to choose His way of living, not the way of the world. There is hope for us to be righteous in the sight of God. But choosing to follow Jesus involves an act of our will, choosing love and toward others, and reconciliation with our enemies. Let’s begin!

Siguiendo el Camino de Jesús

Jesús dice: "Si su justicia no es mayor que la de los escribas y fariseos, ciertamente no entrarán ustedes en el Reino de los cielos." Sus oyentes quizás se preguntaron cómo podrían aspirar a superar la justicia de los escribas y fariseos. Pero la "justicia" no proviene de cumplir los mandamientos, sino de elegir amar como Dios nos ha amado. Jesús dice: "Han oído que se dijo..." y luego cita algunos de los mandamientos, y continúa con las palabras: "Pero yo les digo..." y nos enseña cómo ser verdaderamente justos. Por ejemplo, el mandamiento "No matarás" puede ser violado al ser grosero e insultar a otra persona, "golpeándola" con palabras de enojo. Jesús enseña a sus oyentes cómo ser verdaderamente "grandes" en el reino de los cielos. "Si traes tu ofrenda al altar y allí recuerdas que tu hermano tiene algo contra ti, deja allí tu ofrenda delante del altar, ve primero a reconciliarte con tu hermano, y luego vuelve y presenta tu ofrenda." Quienes escuchan a Jesús y actúan según su modo de vida están en una mejor posición para vivir con rectitud que los escribas y fariseos, quienes pensaban que bastaba con cumplir la letra de la ley. Nuestra primera lectura de hoy, del libro de Sirácides, dice: "Ante el hombre están la vida y la muerte, el bien y el mal; lo que elija, eso se le dará; a lo que elija, extienda su mano." Jesús nos enseña cómo agradar a Dios. Queremos elegir su camino, no el del mundo. Hay esperanza para que seamos justos a los ojos de Dios. Pero elegir seguir a Jesús implica un acto de nuestra voluntad, elegir el amor hacia los demás y la reconciliación con nuestros enemigos. ¡Comencemos!

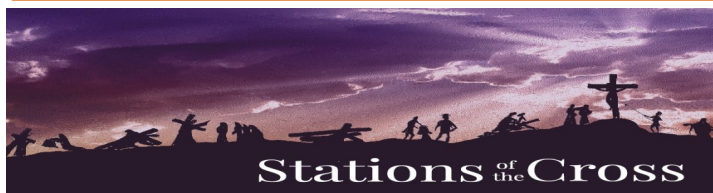

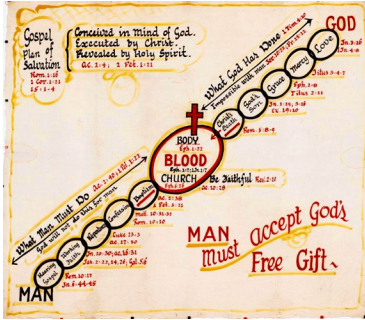
