

The Transfiguration of Jesus

Jesus had told the Apostles that He would suffer and die, and that he would later rise from the dead, but they did not understand. The Transfiguration of Jesus is mentioned in three of the Gospels. In Mark's Gospel, Peter, James, and John obey Jesus by not speaking about what they had just seen on the mountain, but they wonder among themselves what Jesus means by saying that he will rise from the dead. Only after the death of Jesus, and His resurrection on the third day, did Peter, James, and John announce to everyone what they had seen and heard that day, because by then they knew what He meant by “rising from the dead”! Especially when the Holy Spirit had come upon them on Pentecost, as Jesus had promised, they understood His words, and they fearlessly spread the Good News to people all over the world, even to those who would persecute them. Though we were not present to witness the Transfiguration of our Lord, we can consider ourselves witnesses with the eyes of faith. The Gospels were written for us to hear, and Jesus wants us also to see Him in Heavenly glory with two of his faithful servants, Moses and Elijah. We know that not long after this event, the disciples would see Jesus die on the cross in terrible agony. But remembering that they had seen His glory beforehand would help them to believe in the life of Heaven. We want to help others who might feel that “all is lost” so that they do not despair. We want to remember the Father's voice, saying, “This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to Him.” And we want to remember that Jesus said, “Be not afraid!”



La Transfiguración de Jesús

Jesús les había dicho a los apóstoles que sufriría y moriría, y que luego resucitaría de entre los muertos, pero ellos no lo entendieron. La Transfiguración de Jesús se menciona en tres de los Evangelios. En el Evangelio de Marcos, Pedro, Santiago, y Juan obedecen a Jesús al no hablar de lo que acababan de ver en la montaña, pero se preguntan entre ellos qué quiere decir Jesús al decir que resucitará de entre los muertos. Solo después de la muerte de Jesús y su resurrección al tercer día, Pedro, Santiago, y Juan anunciaron a todos lo que habían visto y oído ese día, ¡porque para entonces sabían lo que quería decir con "resucitar de entre los muertos"! Especialmente cuando el Espíritu Santo descendió sobre ellos en Pentecostés, como Jesús había prometido, entendieron sus palabras y difundieron sin temor la Buena Nueva a personas de todo el mundo, incluso a aquellos que los perseguirían. Aunque no estuvimos presentes para presenciar la Transfiguración de nuestro Señor, podemos considerarnos testigos con los ojos de la fe. Los Evangelios fueron escritos para que los escucháramos, y Jesús también quiere que lo veamos en la gloria celestial con dos de sus fieles siervos, Moisés y Elías. Sabemos que no mucho después de este evento, los discípulos verían a Jesús morir en la cruz en terrible agonía. Pero recordar que habían visto Su gloria de antemano les ayudaría a creer en la vida del Cielo. Queremos ayudar a otros que puedan sentir que "todo está perdido" para que no se desesperen. Queremos recordar la voz del Padre, que dice: "Este es mi Hijo amado, en quien me complazco; escúchenlo". Y queremos recordar que Jesús dijo: "¡No teman!"




