

Jesus and the Woman at the Well

The conversation of Jesus with the Samaritan woman at the well in today's gospel was a wonderful blessing in disguise for her and her whole village! Jesus desired to draw her closer to God. When he said, “Go, call your husband, and come back,” he knew that she'd had a rough life. She responded, “I have no husband,” and Jesus knew that it was because she'd had five husbands and was now living with another man. Because of this, she would have been considered a “sinful” woman, and must have suffered a lot. Jesus reveals that he knows about her not to condemn her, but to invite her to drink from the “living water”, the Holy Spirit, which he provides. She was so happy to have met someone who understood her and told her the truth that she ran to tell everyone else! As the villagers came to see the man about whom she was telling them, Jesus told his apostles to “look up and see the fields ripe for the harvest,” referring to the people whom the woman was leading to the well, all of whom were about to be “harvested” for God by coming to faith in Jesus. As we go about our routines like the woman who came to draw water from the well, we may find the Lord speaking to us. Definitely at Mass. Or if we open ourselves to him by reading something spiritual—some book, or perhaps in some silent time when we're walking and thinking or praying. Maybe in a homily or in an article we read. The same Lord whom that woman met at the well might be “talking” to us. We should hope that we will recognize the Truth, whatever it may be, even if it hurts, and realize that we are being invited to come closer to God, to drink the living water that Jesus provides.

Jesús y la Mujer Junto al Pozo

La conversación de Jesús con la samaritana junto al pozo en el evangelio de hoy fue una maravillosa bendición disfrazada para ella y todo su pueblo. Jesús deseaba acercarla a Dios. Cuando le dijo: "Ve, llama a tu marido y regresa," sabía que había tenido una vida difícil. Ella respondió: "No tengo marido," y Jesús supo que era porque había tenido cinco maridos y ahora vivía con otro hombre. Por eso, habría sido considerada una mujer "pecadora", y debió haber sufrido mucho. Jesús revela que la conoce, no para condenarla, sino para invitarla a beber del "agua viva", el Espíritu Santo, que él provee. ¡Estaba tan feliz de haber conocido a alguien que la comprendiera y le dijera la verdad que corrió a contárselo a todos! Cuando los aldeanos fueron a ver al hombre del cual ella les estaba hablando, Jesús les dijo a sus apóstoles que "miren hacia arriba y vean los campos maduros para la cosecha", refiriéndose a las personas que la mujer estaba guiando al pozo, todos los cuales estaban a punto de ser "cosechados" para Dios al llegar a la fe en Jesús. A medida que realizamos nuestras rutinas como la mujer que fue a sacar agua del pozo, podemos encontrar al Señor hablándonos. Definitivamente en la misa. O si nos abrimos a él leyendo algo espiritual, algún libro, o tal vez en un momento de silencio cuando caminamos y pensamos u oramos. Tal vez en una homilía o en un artículo que leemos. El mismo Señor que esa mujer conoció en el pozo podría estar "hablándonos". Debemos esperar reconocer la Verdad, sea cual sea, incluso si duele, y darnos cuenta de que estamos siendo invitados a acercarnos a Dios, a beber el agua viva que Jesús proporciona.




