

Jesus Heals the Man Born Blind

The disciples were quite mistaken when they asked Jesus “Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?” Jesus says that “It is so that the works of God might be made visible through him.” Then Jesus gives the man the ability to see! Jesus is truly the light of the world. The man born blind sees that Jesus is a prophet, and when the Pharisees call Jesus a sinner, he defends Jesus by saying, “If this man were not from God, he would not be able to do anything.” And for that, the poor man is thrown out of the synagogue, persecuted by the religious authorities because he defends Jesus. The Pharisees see themselves as judges, and Jesus and his followers as sinners. In the end, however, Jesus shows himself to be the judge, and the Pharisees, blinded by the hardness of their hearts and held fast by their sins, are really the ones to be pitied. The man born blind now sees that Jesus is the Lord, and he is filled with joy. As for the Pharisees, unless they soften their hearts and admit that Jesus is a holy man; unless they accept that the miraculous giving of sight to the blind man gives glory to God, they will remain blind. Now, what about us? We are hard-hearted at times. At times, we might also refuse to see good in someone whom we don't like. But the goodness of God surrounds us; all creation is heavenly because it was designed by God, who is love. We have the power to make things more heavenly, or we can choose to make things hellish. It is good for us to ask God to remove our blindness so that we can see the goodness and beauty around us and in other people. Perhaps we can help others to see the goodness that is within them. We hope that “the works of God might be made visible” through our words and actions.

Jesús Da la Vista al Hombre Nacido Ciego

Los discípulos se equivocaron mucho cuando le preguntaron a Jesús: "Maestro, ¿quién pecó, este hombre o sus padres, para que naciera ciego?" Jesús dice: "Para que las obras de Dios se hagan visibles a través de él." Entonces Jesús le da al hombre la capacidad de ver. Jesús es verdaderamente la luz del mundo. El hombre que nació ciego ve que Jesús es un profeta, y cuando los fariseos llaman a Jesús pecador, lo defiende diciendo: "Si este hombre no viniera de Dios, no podría hacer nada." Y por eso, el pobre hombre es expulsado de la sinagoga, perseguido por las autoridades religiosas porque defiende a Jesús. Los fariseos se ven a sí mismos como jueces, y a Jesús y sus seguidores como pecadores. Al final, sin embargo, Jesús se muestra como el juez, y los fariseos, cegados por la dureza de sus corazones, y aferrados a sus pecados, son realmente los que deben ser compadecidos. El ciego de nacimiento ahora ve que Jesús es el Señor y se llena de alegría. En cuanto a los fariseos, a menos que ablanden su corazón y admitan que Jesús es un hombre santo; a menos que acepten que el milagro de la vista al ciego glorifica a Dios, permanecerán ciegos. Ahora bien, ¿qué pasa con nosotros? A veces somos duros de corazón. A veces, también podríamos negarnos a ver lo bueno en alguien que no nos gusta. Pero la bondad de Dios nos rodea; toda la creación es celestial porque fue diseñada por Dios, que es amor. Tenemos el poder de hacer las cosas más celestiales, o podemos elegir hacerlas infernales. Es bueno que le pidamos a Dios que elimine nuestra ceguera para que podamos ver la bondad y la belleza que nos rodea y en otras personas. Tal vez podamos ayudar a otros a ver la bondad que hay dentro de ellos. Esperamos que "las obras de Dios se hagan visibles" a través de nuestras palabras y acciones.



FIRST SATURDAY HOLY ROSARY


