3rd Sunday of Easter

After Jesus rose from the dead, He appeared to many people who frequently did not immediately recognize Him, including Mary Magdalene on that Easter morning. The two men in today's Gospel had the wonderful experience of talking with Jesus and listening to Him as they walked for seven miles to the village of Emmaus. They invited Jesus to dine with them, and it was “in the breaking of the bread” that their eyes were opened! Whereupon He vanished from their sight! They said, “Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?” What does this mean? Meeting the Risen Jesus had changed their lives forever! Perhaps Jesus was teaching them, and us, that we are not to look for Him anymore as the man with the beard who looked the way He used to look. He is teaching us all that, now He will be with us in a new way. He has given us the Sacraments! He has sent us His Spirit. Last week, we heard how He instituted the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Easter Sunday so that sins could be forgiven all over the world. Today, we hear how we are to recognize Him at Mass, “in the breaking of the bread”. The risen Lord Jesus is here! Our hearts should be burning within us as in the hearts of those two disciples. We are to understand that God's power is over us, and even with all the troubles in our world today, God loves us. Even though we may walk through the valley of the shadow of death, the Good Shepherd is with us. We can expect to meet Jesus under many different appearances, and His Spirit will allow us to recognize Him with the eyes of faith.

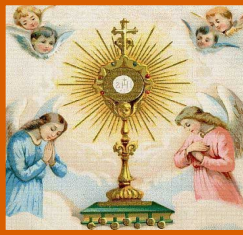

Tercer Domingo de Pascua

Después de que Jesús resucitó de entre los muertos, se apareció a muchas personas que, con frecuencia, no lo reconocieron de inmediato; entre ellas, María Magdalena, en aquella mañana de Pascua. Los dos hombres del Evangelio de hoy tuvieron la maravillosa experiencia de conversar con Jesús y escucharlo mientras caminaban siete millas hacia la aldea de Emaús. Invitaron a Jesús a cenar con ellos, y fue "al partir el pan" cuando se les abrieron los ojos. ¡Acto seguido, Él desapareció de su vista! Dijeron: "¿Acaso no ardía nuestro corazón en nuestro interior mientras nos hablaba en el camino y nos explicaba las Escrituras?" ¿Qué significa esto? ¡El encuentro con Jesús Resucitado había transformado sus vidas para siempre! Quizás Jesús les estaba enseñando a ellos —y a nosotros— que ya no debemos buscarlo como a aquel hombre barbado que tenía el aspecto de antaño. Nos está enseñando a todos que, de ahora en adelante, estará con nosotros de una manera nueva. ¡Nos ha entregado los Sacramentos! Nos ha enviado su Espíritu. La semana pasada escuchamos cómo Él instituyó el Sacramento de la Reconciliación el Domingo de Pascua, para que los pecados pudieran ser perdonados en todo el mundo. Hoy escuchamos cómo debemos reconocerlo en la Misa: "en la fracción del pan." ¡El Señor Jesús resucitado está aquí! Nuestros corazones deberían arder dentro de nosotros, como en los corazones de aquellos dos discípulos. Debemos comprender que el poder de Dios está sobre nosotros y que, incluso con todas las dificultades que hoy existen en nuestro mundo, Dios nos ama. Aunque caminemos por el valle de sombra de muerte, el Buen Pastor está con nosotros. Podemos esperar encontrarnos con Jesús bajo muchas apariencias diferentes, y su Espíritu nos permitirá reconocerlo con los ojos de la fe.

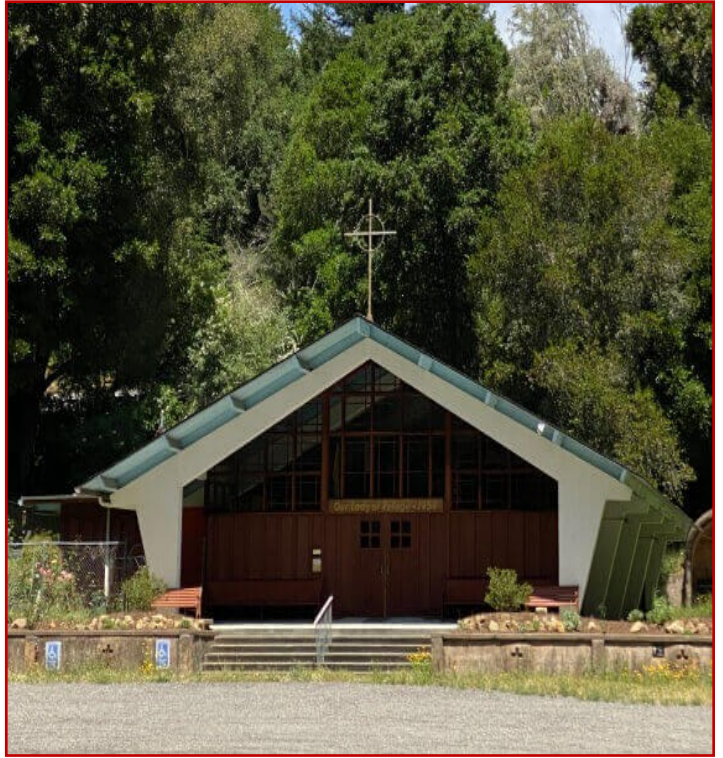
