Good Shepherd Sunday

Today is “Good Shepherd Sunday”, also “World Day of Prayer for Vocations”. The vocations which Our Lord makes—his calls—are to the priesthood, where men are ordained to model their lives after the Good Shepherd. But vocations are not only to the priesthood, though, of course, that is what is usually meant by a “vocation”. God calls each of us. He calls us into existence. In Baptism, he calls us into a new life in the Church. In today’s reading from the Acts of the Apostles, Peter says, “Repent, and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.” God has a vocation for everybody! Most people get married and bring children into the world, parents really are shepherds to whom God entrusts their precious little “sheep”. In our second reading, St. Peter says, “You had gone astray like sheep, but you have now returned to the shepherd and guardian of your souls.” Jesus says, “Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture.” The closer we stay to the Good Shepherd, the safer and happier we’ll be. Sheep who have been scattered may, through our guidance and God’s power, be brought to safety. We should pray that young people may respond generously to the call of the Holy Spirit in deepening their faith and choosing their vocation in life. If married men and women live out their vocation with selfless love, modeled after the love of Christ for His Church, the natural fruit of their love will be children who will answer God’s call to priesthood and the religious life, having learned how to love from their family.

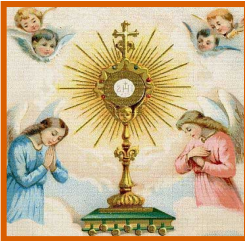

Domingo del Buen Pastor

Hoy es el "Domingo del Buen Pastor", y también la "Jornada Mundial de Oración por las Vocaciones". Las vocaciones que nuestro Señor suscita—sus llamados—son al sacerdocio, donde los hombres son ordenados para modelar sus vidas a imagen del Buen Pastor. Sin embargo, las vocaciones no se limitan únicamente al sacerdocio, aunque, por supuesto, eso es lo que habitualmente se entiende por "vocación". Dios nos llama a cada uno de nosotros. Nos llama a la existencia. En el Bautismo, nos llama a una vida nueva dentro de la Iglesia. En la lectura de hoy de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, Pedro dice: "Arrepíentanse y bautícese cada uno de ustedes en el nombre de Jesucristo para el perdón de sus pecados; y recibirán el don del Espíritu Santo." ¡Dios tiene una vocación para cada persona! La mayoría de las personas contraen matrimonio y traen hijos al mundo; los padres son, en verdad, pastores a quienes Dios confía sus preciosas y pequeñas "ovejas". En nuestra segunda lectura, San Pedro dice: "Ustedes andaban descarriados como ovejas, pero ahora han regresado al Pastor y Guardián de sus almas." Jesús dice: "Quien entre por mí se salvará; entrará, saldrá y encontrará pastos." Cuanto más cerca permanezcamos del Buen Pastor, más seguros y felices seremos. Las ovejas que se han dispersado pueden, gracias a nuestra guía y al poder de Dios, ser puestas a salvo. Debemos orar para que los jóvenes respondan generosamente al llamado del Espíritu Santo, profundizando en su fe y eligiendo su vocación en la vida. Si los hombres y mujeres casados viven su vocación con un amor abnegado—modelado a imagen del amor de Cristo por su Iglesia—, el fruto natural de su amor serán hijos que responderán al llamado de Dios al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa, habiendo aprendido a amar en el seno de su familia.

Our two Coastsides Conferences at Our Lady of the Pillar and St. Anthony's Mission operate regularly scheduled food distributions at pantries in Half Moon Bay and Pescadero and provide groceries to over 400 Coastsides families every month.
