### The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ

In today's Gospel (John 6:51-58), Jesus says to the Jewish crowds: “I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.”

The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, “How can this man give us his flesh to eat?” Jesus said to them, “Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever.”

*Jesus told us how we will one day be judged, saying that whatever we do to the least of those around us, we do to Him. So, our reverence and respect for the Body and Blood of Jesus on the altar must be extended to the members of the Mystical Body of Christ, our brothers and sisters, in the Church. And if we treat others with the love that they deserve, we will also grow much closer to our Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.*

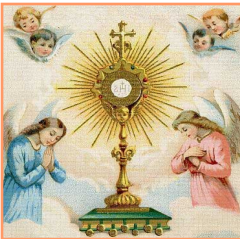

## El Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo

En el Evangelio de hoy (Juan 6:51-58), Jesús dice a las multitudes judías: "Yo soy el pan vivo que bajó del cielo; el que coma de este pan vivirá para siempre; y el pan que yo daré es mi carne para la vida del mundo".

Los judíos discutían entre sí, diciendo: "¿Cómo puede este hombre darnos a comer su carne?". Jesús les dijo: "En verdad, en verdad les digo: si no comen la carne del Hijo del hombre y no beben su sangre, no tienen vida en ustedes. El que come mi carne y bebe mi sangre tiene vida eterna, y yo lo resucitaré en el último día. Porque mi carne es verdadera comida, y mi sangre es verdadera bebida. El que come mi carne y bebe mi sangre permanece en mí y yo en él. Así como el Padre viviente me envió y yo tengo vida por el Padre, así también el que se alimenta de mí tendrá vida por mí. Este es el pan que bajó del cielo. A diferencia de sus antepasados, que comieron y aun así murieron, el que coma de este pan vivirá para siempre".

*Jesús nos reveló cómo seremos juzgados algún día, al decir que todo cuanto hagamos por el más pequeño de quienes nos rodean, lo hacemos por Él. Por tanto, nuestra reverencia y respeto hacia el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús en el altar deben extenderse a los miembros del Cuerpo Místico de Cristo—nuestros hermanos y hermanas—dentro de la Iglesia. Y si tratamos a los demás con el amor que merecen, también nos acercaremos mucho más a nuestro Señor Jesucristo en la Eucaristía.*
