11th Sunday in Ordinary Time

We go through our lives like small children, like the crowds who seemed to Jesus to be troubled and abandoned like sheep without a shepherd to guide them. We each have troubles which get all our attention. But our Good Shepherd is watching over us; God loves His children *infinitely* more than any parent can. “We are his people: the sheep of his flock.” as in today’s Responsorial Psalm. And in our Reading from Exodus, God says, “You shall be my special possession, dearer to me than all other people.” God does not get weary watching over us, listening to our prayers. In fact, God is *pleased* when we pray to him, especially if our prayers are united with His will, and when we pray for *others*. Because *then* we are becoming more like God! And since we were made in the image and likeness of God, our Heavenly Father is happy to see us growing up to be generous, thoughtful, and forgiving toward others, especially our enemies. And also when we take *delight* in the world and its beauty. When we enjoy playing and having a good time, our Father also delights in us, His children, but He is concerned that we don’t wander into danger. There are many *glamorous* attractions that “the world” offers us which entice us into sin, where we forget God and end up as “lost sheep”, or perhaps as “dead sheep”. Jesus sent The Twelve to the *lost sheep* of Israel. All of us, as members of the one Body of Christ, have a part to play. We must be *stronger* in our faith, praying more fervently for *help*. We are in danger, like lost sheep. But in the Church we are in a safe place, because of the Good Shepherd who always calls us to follow Him *more closely from now on*.

Undécimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

De hecho, a Dios le complace que le oremos, especialmente si nuestras oraciones se unen a su voluntad y si rezamos por los demás. ¡Porque así nos vamos asemejando más a Dios! Y puesto que fuimos creados a imagen y semejanza de Dios, nuestro Padre Celestial se alegra al vernos crecer y ser generosos, considerados y capaces de perdonar a los demás, incluso a nuestros enemigos. También se alegra cuando disfrutamos del mundo y de su belleza. Cuando gozamos jugando y pasando buenos momentos, nuestro Padre también se deleita en nosotros, sus hijos, aunque se preocupa de que no nos desviemos hacia el peligro. Hay muchas atracciones seductoras que "el mundo" nos ofrece y que nos incitan al pecado; situaciones en las que olvidamos a Dios y terminamos como "ovejas perdidas" o, tal vez, como "ovejas muertas". Jesús envió a los Doce a buscar a las ovejas perdidas de Israel. Todos nosotros, como miembros del único Cuerpo de Cristo, tenemos un papel que desempeñar. Debemos fortalecer nuestra fe y orar con mayor fervor pidiendo ayuda. Estamos en peligro, como ovejas perdidas. Pero en la Iglesia nos encontramos a salvo, gracias al Buen Pastor que siempre nos llama a seguirlo más de cerca de ahora en adelante.

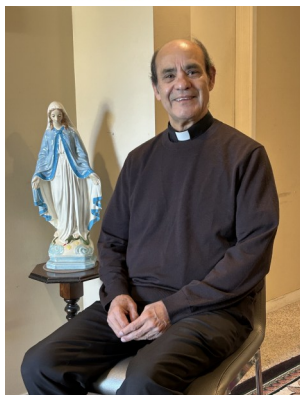
