Reflection on Today's Readings

Jesus says that if a person loves father or mother, or son or daughter, more than they love Him, they are not worthy of Him. If anyone other than Jesus said those words, we could be rightfully shocked, but since Jesus is the Son of God, His words are correct. He also says, “Whoever receives you receives me, and whoever receives me receives the one who sent me.” So, whoever welcomes Jesus into his or her life, is also welcoming God the Father, the One who sent Jesus into the world. And, of course, if we want to love any other person, especially our mother or father, a brother or sister or spouse, we must have love and respect for God as the foundation of our love. Too often some people treat others in ways that make it obvious that their relationships were never built on the necessary foundation of faith in God. There have been too many stories of people saying, “I love you so much that if you leave me, I’ll kill you!” That is not love, but extreme selfishness. Pope Benedict XVI wrote that, “When God is regarded as a secondary matter that can be set aside temporarily or permanently on account of more important things, it is precisely these more important things that come to nothing.” Jesus gives us an example of self-sacrificing love that leads to true life. By giving of ourselves, we receive. Love God, and love your neighbor. Only if we love and respect God above all else are we able to love anyone else. We need a “moral compass” that always points toward God. Then we will arrive at our destination, Heaven, where we can live with everyone else in God’s kingdom in the love that never ends.

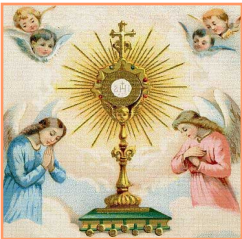

Reflexión Sobre las Lecturas de Hoy

Jesús dice que si una persona ama a su padre o a su madre, o a su hijo o a su hija, más que a Él, no es digna de Él. Si alguien que no fuera Jesús pronunciara esas palabras, con razón nos sentiríamos escandalizados; pero, dado que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios, sus palabras son acertadas. Él también dice: "Quien los recibe a ustedes, me recibe a mí; y quien me recibe a mí, recibe a Aquel que me envió." Por tanto, quien acoge a Jesús en su vida, acoge también a Dios Padre, Aquel que envió a Jesús al mundo. Y, por supuesto, si queremos amar a cualquier otra persona—especialmente a nuestra madre o a nuestro padre, a un hermano, a una hermana o al cónyuge—debemos tener el amor y el respeto a Dios como fundamento de nuestro amor. Con demasiada frecuencia, algunas personas tratan a los demás de tal manera que resulta evidente que sus relaciones nunca se edificaron sobre el fundamento necesario de la fe en Dios. Son demasiados los casos de personas que dicen: "¡Te quiero tanto que, si me dejas, te mato!" Eso no es amor, sino un egoísmo extremo. El Papa Benedicto XVI escribió: "Cuando se considera a Dios como algo secundario, que puede dejarse de lado temporal o permanentemente en favor de cosas más importantes, son precisamente esas cosas más importantes las que terminan en nada." Jesús nos da un ejemplo de amor abnegado que conduce a la vida verdadera. Al entregarnos a los demás, recibimos. Ama a Dios y ama a tu prójimo. Solo si amamos y respetamos a Dios por encima de todo somos capaces de amar a los demás. Necesitamos una "brújula moral" que apunte siempre hacia Dios. Así llegaremos a nuestro destino, el Cielo, donde podremos vivir con todos en el reino de Dios, en el amor que nunca termina.

The Archdiocese has announced that Rev. Antonio “Andy” de Guzman will be our new Parish Administrator, beginning July 1st.

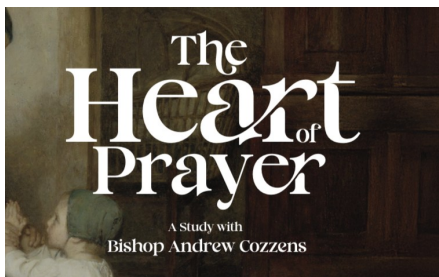
RECITATION OF THE HOLY ROSARY
