Forgive As You Have Been Forgiven

Every human being in Heaven is now a saint who has been forgiven every sin that he or she has ever committed. Saints understand our Lord's words about having their entire debt forgiven, and want to extend that mercy and forgiveness even to those who have sinned against them. They pray for those who persecuted them. They pray for those who killed them! They are filled with Heavenly happiness because of God's mercy on them, and it is unthinkable that they would refuse to forgive anyone else. Here on Earth, we may have to demand that a person make amends for his crimes, and "pay his debt to society". But if the Kingdom of Heaven is within us (as it truly is when we have received the Holy Spirit in Baptism), then we will cooperate with the Spirit of God, and ask our Lord to help us be reconciled with others—even our enemies! We see so much anger and hatred around us. We hear about "road rage", and we see senseless violence on our streets. People strike out with cruelty against total strangers! This is evidence of a spirit that is definitely not of God! We should be wary of allowing such a spirit of hatred or revenge to influence us, but rather, beg God to make us instruments of His peace. None of us is too young or too old to be able to bring God's peace to someone else simply by nurturing that peace in our own heart. God comes to us in Word and Sacrament to strengthen us in holiness. When we leave Mass, we want to be bearers of that peace in every moment of our life. God will use us to heal the wounds of others who need to experience His peace. Each of us can be a blessing to those we encounter in our ordinary lives in this world.

Oímos hablar de la "ira al volante" y vemos violencia sin sentido en nuestras calles. ¡Hay personas que arremeten con crueldad contra completos desconocidos! ¡Esto es prueba de un espíritu que definitivamente no proviene de Dios! Debemos cuidarnos de permitir que tal espíritu de odio o venganza nos influya; más bien, debemos suplicar a Dios que nos haga instrumentos de su paz. Nadie es demasiado joven ni demasiado viejo para llevar la paz de Dios a otra persona, simplemente cultivando esa paz en su propio corazón. Dios viene a nosotros en la Palabra y en los Sacramentos para fortalecernos en la santidad. Al salir de Misa, deseamos ser portadores de esa paz en cada momento de nuestra vida. Dios nos utilizará para sanar las heridas de aquellos que necesitan experimentar su paz. Podemos ser una bendición para aquellos con quienes nos encontramos en la vida cotidiana.
