





A master class dedicated to photography, to showcase equestrian art through imagery.




The organization of a poetry contest dedicated to the horse.

GRAND PRIX OF HIS MAJESTY KING MOHAMMED VI OF TBOURIDA

From september 30th to october 4th, 2025

The Grand Prix of His Majesty King Mohammed VI of Tbourida, a flagship highlight of the Salon du Cheval d'El Jadida, will return this year to the spectacular arena of Mohammed VI Exhibition Park from September 30th to October 4th, 2025. Held under the High Patronage of His Majesty King Mohammed VI, may God glorify Him, this prestigious event celebrates the ancestral art of Tbourida, a deeply rooted Moroccan equestrian tradition that showcases the skill, harmony and bravery of riders and their horses.

Each team strives to impress not only with speed but also through perfect coordination, the quality of harnesses and collective discipline, all meticulously assessed by a panel of expert judges.

The 2025 edition follows in the footsteps of previous years while further strengthening the prestige of this key event through the selection of high-level invited troupes, chosen for their technical mastery and their commitment to traditional codes.

The Grand Prix holds a central place in the program of Salon du Cheval d'El Jadida, attracting audiences from across Morocco and beyond. Families, professionals, equestrian art enthusiasts and institutions gather to celebrate a living heritage that transcends the boundaries of competition. October 4th , 2025





ART COMPETITION FOR YOUNG TALENTS

October 1st 2025



Beyond sporting competitions and equestrian performances, the Salon du Cheval d'El Jadida places a special focus on the educational and cultural dimension by organizing, each year, an art competition dedicated to younger generations. In perfect harmony with the theme of this edition, "Horse Welfare, a Link Between Equestrian Practices", this initiative is aimed for students aged from 12 to 17, from both public and private schools, across the provinces and prefectures of El Jadida, Berkane, Al Hoceima, Laayoune, Skhirate–Temara and Fes.

POETRY COMPETITION

CHILDREN'S AREA.



Supervised demonstrations and themed activities allow them to develop an initial connection with the animal in a safe and welcoming environment. Guided by specialized professionals, these experiences often serve as a child's first meaningful encounter with the equestrian world, moments that inspire both learning and emotion.









VILLAGE. ART AND CULTURE

The Art and Culture Village holds a unique place within the Salon du Cheval d'El Jadida. Conceived as a space for dialogue between contemporary creation, cultural heritage and popular expression, it highlights the deep and enduring ties between the horse and Moroccan culture across centuries. Visitors are invited to explore a diverse journey where artistic exhibitions, live performances, craftsmanship, literature, music and traditional knowhow come together.

Painters, sculptors, calligraphers, photographers, storytellers and musicians present works inspired by the equestrian world, its aesthetics, its symbolism and its evocative power. Through their creative perspectives, the horse becomes both an artistic motif and a source of emotion, a witness to history and a figure of cultural transmission.

As a place of interaction, the Art and Culture Village also hosts conferences, author meet-and-greets, public readings, and workshops introducing visitors to artistic professions. Round tables will focus on themes such as the representation of the horse in Moroccan culture, the role of the arts in preserving traditions, and the place of art in equestrian education.

Under the theme "Melodies of Hooves", these unique shows will blend tradition, virtuosity, and emotion, bringing together international artists and renowned Moroccan institutions to offer audiences an unprecedented experience at the crossroads of equestrian art and live performance.
