Please initial each statement.

- _____ It is the homeowners responsibility to maintain the integrity of their Sewer Isolation Valve, and ensure it is accessible. If it is not accessible and can't be shut off sewage may backflow into your sewer system.
- _____ The County Sewer System is a gray water system, which requires the use of a septic tank for each resident. The County maintains the main line, and each respective property owner owns their tank, service line to main line, and pressure pump (in some areas only).
- _____ Benewah County pumps your septic tank (at no additional charge to you) once in a ten-year period. If your tank has not been pumped within the ten-year period, solids may pass through eventually plugging the service or main line and causing system disruption. Exposing the access lid is the responsibility of the owner. If your tank needs pumped please call Benewah County at 208-245-3212.
