

2026 PROPERTY TAX BENEFIT FOR DISABLED VETERANS

100% Service-Connected Disability

Application Deadline - April 15th, 2026

QUALIFICATIONS

1. You owned and lived in a home or manufactured home in Idaho that was your primary residence **before APRIL 15, 2026.** (You may qualify if you live in a care facility or nursing home.)
2. The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs recognizes you as 100% service-connected disabled, or you receive 100% compensation due to individual unemployability.

DOCUMENTATION

- The State Tax Commission requires a letter from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs confirming your 100% service-connected disability rating or individual unemployability as of **January 1, 2026.**

NOTES

- This benefit **is** automatically renewed.
- if approved, your benefit will appear on your December 2026 property tax bill.
- You may also qualify for the Property Tax Reduction (Circuit Breaker) benefit if:
 - Your income for **2025** was **\$39,130** or less (does not include your VA income) and
 - the home value doesn't exceed a limit set by law that will be calculated in **June 2026.**
- Benefits granted to qualifying veterans who die, the surviving spouse can use it for the current property. The benefit isn't transferrable to a new property.
