TCSND Uniform & Equipment 2026-2027

The uniform is non-gender specific/ should be worn to and from school every day.

Uniform

- The school navy blue 'V-neck' jumper* with our logo which must be worn (unless directed otherwise)
- White polo shirt with school logo*
- Navy blue formal school trousers worn around the waist (use a belt if required)– no chinos or jeans
- Formal navy-blue shorts or a formal navy-blue school pleated skirt worn just above or on the knee.
- Plain black flat leather shoes or plain all black flat leather trainers (leather includes leather-style). No soft canvas or knitted trainers such as running trainers or Converse. No boots. No canvas/suede shoes.
- Plain black or dark navy coat only – no logos, no denim or leather jackets
- Plain navy blue/ black knee or ankle height socks or plain black or navy-blue tights. No leggings
- Tracksuit tops and hooded tops are not allowed in school and should not be worn as coats.
- Long sleeve tops may not be worn under the polo shirt.
- No jewellery allowed – except for one small stud in the ear and/or nose.
- No other piercings allowed.
- False eyelashes or nail extensions may not be worn.
- Hair must be of a natural colour.
- No tattoos of any description.
- Plain black headbands can be worn. No other headwear is allowed to be worn on the school premises except for religious/ medical reasons.
- Any winter scarves worn to and from school should be put away during the school day and not worn in school.
- School Lanyard for specific year group (This is provided by the school)
- Faraday phone pouch provided by the school – if lost, replacements can be purchased through the school

Any student not complying with the school uniform policy will be asked to change into school compliant uniform provided on loan for the day by the school and will receive a sanction, unless there is an explanation provided that is considered reasonable by the school. The school also reserves the right to send a student home to change into the correct uniform.

Jewellery and other prohibited items will be confiscated until the end of the day, and a sanction will be issued.

The sanction issued will range from a first warning to a 60 minute detention depending on the circumstances and frequency of the non-compliance.

PE Kit

- Plain navy blue or black sport shorts, skirt, skorts or leggings.
- Navy or black jogging/tracksuit bottoms.
- Charter PE T-shirt*.
- Navy Plain Sweatshirt – No hoodies.
- Non-marking trainers.
- Football boots for lessons on the field.
- Plain navy or black socks.

Students who do not bring correct PE kit will be issued a detention and parents/carers will be notified.

Equipment – Ready to Learn

Every student must bring a school bag big enough to carry A4 folders and books every day. The following basic items need to be in the bag:

Pencil case containing:

ESSENTIAL

- 2 x black biros/ pens
- 2 x pencils
- 1 x green biro/ pen
- 1 x 30cm Ruler
- 1 x Calculator
- White board pen

RECOMMENDED

- Coloured pencils and highlighter pens
- Pencil sharpener and eraser

The school bag must also contain:

ESSENTIAL

- The School Planner
- Exercise books as required
- A reading book
- PE kit if required that day
- Any other equipment required by subjects.

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Examples of trainers allowed: plain all black leather or leather-style



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Examples of black trainers NOT allowed: canvas/knitted, multi-coloured, Converse, wedged.
