Summary	In no more than 250 words, summarise why your organisation deserves to win this award, highlighting the Al or digital health innovation implemented.
Background & Research	Provide details on the background and research behind your Al or digital health initiative. Explain the challenge or need that prompted its development.
Positive Effects of the Technology	Describe the measurable impact of your Al or digital health solution on patients, services, or your organisation. Explain why it was successful.
Plans going forward	Outline your plans to further enhance or expand the technology to meet future demands and the needs of upcoming generations.
User Feedback	Include analysis of user surveys, reviews, or feedback forms to demonstrate the effectiveness and acceptance of the technology.

Essential tips for a successful entry

A successful application must try to address all of the points above. Marks will be allocated only on the evidence provided.

Use the headings shown to highlight your answers to those specific questions. Include information on your exceptional successes during the year such as systems, innovations or techniques that have reaped significant benefits.

Concentrate on facts that can be substantiated. Attachments can be included, which are particularly important for the judges to be able to see your successes or innovations.

Please remember that ONLY THE FIRST 2000 words of core information (and supporting material that you may have provided) of your submission will be assessed
