- Tours available to be booked daily, mid-April to mid-October, 10am to 4pm (except statutory holidays)
- The terrain at the outdoor locations is uneven and unpaved in areas. A confident level of mobility is required for this experience.
- Suitable walking shoes are recommended for this experience.
- This tour is weather dependent and will be cancelled in the event of rain.
- Bookings are considered subject to the availability of the Indigenous Knowledge Keepers that lead the tour experience (min 12 / max 20)
- Transportation provided from your Medicine Hat Hotel
- Tour is weather dependant and may be cancelled or modified in the event of poor weather
