Leaving a Legacy in Your Will

A) Bequest

Designate a specific dollar amount during your estate planning to STEGH Foundation to be used for the purpose of the Highest Priority Needs of STEGH or a specific area of need (i.e. Emergency Department).

Example clause: "I give the sum of \$_____ to the STEGH Foundation to be used in support of the Highest Priority Need."

B) Residual Bequest

Allocate all, or a portion of your estate to STEGH Foundation that remains after all debits, taxes, expense and other bequests are paid.

C) Contingent Bequest

Include a provision in your Will that directs a gift to the STEGH Foundation in the event that your primary beneficiaries predecease you. This ensures your estate can still support causes important to you, such as the STEGH Foundation, if your original intentions cannot be fulfilled.
