Information We Collect

Data Retention

We retain personal information only for as long as reasonably necessary to fulfill the purpose for which it was collected, including business, professional, legal, or record-keeping requirements.

If we become aware that we have received personal information from a minor, we will promptly take reasonable steps to delete such information.
