Bristol Classic Rum goes to great lengths to search out special casks of the greatest Rum available. Our Reserve Rum of Barbados 2011 is a stunning blend of pot & column still, aged in American refill casks for six years before making its way to the UK in 2017. Here, it continued to mature in moist-rich warehousing until it was finally selected for bottling in 2022 at 47% vol/abv.

Pale gold colour leads to soft nose with fruit and well-integrated wood. Here you can also detect hints of of tangerine and dried fruit. This is a typical Foursquare profile displaying the blend of column and pot stills to provide the classic touch of tar, which follows on the palate to a lingering finish. There is enormous elegance as a result of controlled maturation between tropical and continental maturation.

It is very drinkable, so enjoy over ice or with a splash of water.

This Reserve Rum of Barbados 2011 is kept pure and unadulterated, with no additional sugar, chill-filtration or colouring.
