Local ATTRACTIONS

WHITECAP SWIMMING POOL

Whitecap Swimming Pool bustles in summer. Offering public swimming, lane swim, AquaFit, and lessons! This outdoor pool is busy with swimmers seeking to beat the summer heat.

DISC GOLF

Gull Lake's 9-Hole Disc Golf Course at Green Power Ball Park is a fun day activity. The Town Office loans disc sets. Hole 1 begins between the batting cage and second diamond.

GREEN POWER BALL PARK

Gull Lake's ball diamonds are located within the Green Power Ball Park, along Lake Ave. and 2nd St.

CURLING RINK

The four-sheet Gull Lake and District Curling Rink is open November–March. It hosts league curling and a variety of bonspiels.

GULL LAKE HERITAGE WALKING TOUR

Residents and visitors can learn about our rich history on the Heritage Walking Tour, which highlights historic buildings and landmarks. Download the Tripvia App for the tour!

GULL LAKE LIBRARY

The Chinook Regional Library, located at 1379 Conrad Ave., offers a variety of weekly programming for all ages.

GULL LAKE RECREATION COMPLEX

The Recreation Complex, (7275 Lake Ave.) houses the Gull Lake Community Hall, Skating Rink, Bowling Lanes, and Stevenson Athletics.

KINETTE COMMUNITY CORNER MINI GOLF

The northeast corner of Little Green on the Prairie Park features Gull Lake Kinetette Corner Mini-Golf. The Gull Lake Kinetettes run this mini-golf course, which is great for summer fun.

LITTLE GREEN ON THE PRAIRIE

Little Green on the Prairie has a great walking path, a playground, basketball court, and picnic area.

KIASKUS TRAIL

The Kiaskus Walk is a 5-kilometer loop trail that showcases Gull Lake's beautiful greenery and prairie views. The Kiaskus Trail crosses prairies and concrete. Strollers may struggle on some trail stretches. The trail allows leashed dogs. Please clean up after your dog.

SWT LYCEUM THEATRE

MEADOWDALE GOLF COURSE

Meadowdale Golf Course is 5 km east of Gull Lake on the Trans-Canada Highway. This 9-hole, sand green golf course is perfect for family and group practice. The course holds Men's Night on Tuesdays & Ladies Night on Wednesdays during the golf season, as well as various competitions.

MUSEUM

Gull Lake Museum's three buildings—Main Building, School House, and Machine Shop—house exhibits. The Main Building displays Gull Lake's history. The School House is a recreation of a historic school where students studied. Machinery Building showcases agricultural machinery.

PICKLEBALL/TENNIS COURTS

The east side of Gull Lake School's parking lot has two pickleball courts and one tennis court.

XERISCAPE/COMMUNITY GARDEN

The public can visit the downtown Xeriscape/Community Garden on Main Street and Conrad Avenue. The garden has raised beds, trees, plants, a rail fence, a park bench, a birdhouse, fruit trees, and the mini library book exchange.

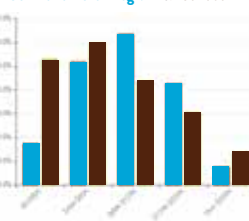

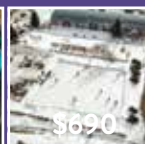
