A Christmas Adoption

Galatians 4:4-7

One of my favorite Christmas hymns is "Come, Thou Long-Expected Jesus." I love it because it captures the heart of Christmas as a rescue mission. It begins, "Come, thou long-expected Jesus, born to set thy people free." Christmas is the story of a God who came down to save us—not because we were worthy or searching for Him, but because of His sovereign love and amazing grace. However, redemption is not the end goal.

Paul says it this way in Galatians 4:4–7:

'But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, 'Abba! Father!' So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God."

Galatians 4 reminds us that the true goal of redemption is adoption. Yes, Christmas is about redemption. Paul says Christ came "to redeem those who were under the law." We were slaves to sin, unable to earn our way to God. But Christ entered our world to buy us back at the price of His own blood.

But Paul goes even further. Christ redeemed us "so that we might receive adoption as sons." He didn't just set us free; He brought us home.

Because of Jesus, we are no longer orphans. No longer slaves. No longer outsiders. In Christ, we become beloved sons and daughters of the living God—fully welcomed, fully known, fully loved. If you are in Christ, you are an heir of God and a co-heir with Christ.

While I certainly enjoy a good rescue mission story, Christmas is about much more than a rescue. It's the story of a Father who sent His Son so that lost sinners could become His children forever.



Building Committee Update

November 18, 2025

Dear Beloved Congregation,

This month, the major milestone was that core drilling officially began. Core drilling is a critical step that will verify whether our developed site plan is truly feasible. Please pray that all goes smoothly with this process and that we will be able to move forward confidently with the current site plan.

If the core drilling results are acceptable, the next step will be to obtain bids from the excavation companies we have already identified. After consulting with excavating companies as well as civil and architectural experts, everyone agrees that completing all site excavation at one time is the most cost-effective approach. Once the full site is prepared, we will be able to add individual sections of the plan one phase at a time.

We have also identified the desired utility locations for the property. The water service can come from a nearby road that has a line large enough for all our needs. For sewer service, we have requested an easement to access the sewer in Willow Creek and hope to receive a response by the first of the year. Early discussions indicate that this should not be a problem, but we ask for continued prayers as we pursue this easement, it is by far the best option for our sewer connection.

We humbly ask for your continued prayers—for our Staff, Trustees, and Building Committee—as we seek God's will for our church and community. Please pray for us as the Spirit leads, and especially for wisdom, love, unity, clarity, and a deep desire to follow God's will and timing in every step of this journey.

Stay tuned for more updates and let us continue to trust in God's perfect timing and direction.
