#### GENEALOGY CORNER

We have an item from member ANTHONY DAWSON of Greensboro, NC. "My cousin, FRANK BABBITT, travelled to Colmonell, Scotland last June and visited the birthplace of my namesake ANTHONY M. DAWSON! He was born at Garnaburn Farm in Colmonell in 1817. Another cousin visited there in 1910 and brought back a photo which I have framed and placed on my mantel. When cousin FRANK told me he was planning to visit, I asked that he go and try to get a new picture. The current residents (not Kennedy) were very hospitable. The current photo reflects that the homeplace looks the same almost 100 years later.

ANTHONY M KENNEDY had four children who survived into adulthood. I am descended from his youngest daughter SARAH KENNEDY BURROWS. My mother, member #69, SARAH KENNEDY DAWSON, was named after her grandmother and my mother named me after her grandmother's father. My mother turned 88 in September and is doing well at an assisted living facility in Sumter, SC. Her 93 year old sister, JULIA ASHBY BURROWS BURRUS, lives there as well. Another sister, GERTRUDE BURROWS BROWN, also survives and is living in Laurens, SC. There must be some good genes somewhere!"


The Kennedy Society of North America, Inc is incorporated in the State of South Carolina as a non-profit social and historical group interested in the history of the Celtic race, particularly the Scots, Scots-Irish, and the Irish Kennedys (however spelled), and the branches of Kennedy and their descendants who immigrated to America. The Society enjoys the patronage of the Most Honourable, the Marquess of Ailsa, Hereditary Chief of Kennedy. This newsletter is the official publication of the Society and is published four times a year, volume numbers beginning with the calendar year. 


