ABSTRACTA x WALL OF ART  
Contemporary art that enhances soundscapes.

Abstracta and the art platform Wall of Art expand their successful collaboration with the launch of six new artworks in the Abstracta x Wall of Art collection – a series of sound-absorbing panels where contemporary art meets high-performance acoustics.

The new artworks broaden the collection and introduce an updated colour palette aligned with current and emerging interior design trends. This year's release includes three new pieces by Annika Hultgren, two by Lisa Wirenfelt, and one new artwork by Lena Wigers.

#### Where Art and Acoustics Meet

Together, Abstracta and Wall of Art have developed a unique solution that integrates high acoustic performance with carefully curated contemporary art. The ambition is to create harmonious soundscapes while adding personality, character, and artistic expression to interior spaces.

Abstracta x Wall of Art is a collection of sound-absorbing artworks featuring five artists: Lena Wigers, Annika Hultgren, Evelina Kroon, Lucrecia Rey Caro, and Lisa Wirenfelt. The works are easy to combine and vary in expression, technique, and temperament.

#### Sustainable materials, high performance

The collection makes no compromises when it comes to art, acoustics, or material choice. The artworks are printed on cotton canvas, backed by a highly effective sound absorber made from textile waste and polyester from recycled PET bottles – a solution designed to minimise environmental impact.

Combined with finely crafted oak frames, the cotton canvas enhances the tactile quality and creates an elegant overall impression, making the artworks ideal for restaurants, hotel lobbies, and co-working spaces. The artworks are available in three sizes – 100 x 140 cm, 70 x 100 cm, and 50 x 70 cm – with frames in untreated oak. Despite a depth of only 45 millimetres, the panels provide excellent acoustic performance and effectively absorb ambient noise in busy environments. Combining multiple artworks enhances both the visual expression and the soundscape.

#### About the artists

**Lisa Wirenfelt** places colour at the centre of her practice. Her works emerge intuitively through colour combinations, words, and patterns that develop organically.

#### About Abstracta

We create better soundscapes. As a pioneer in the field of acoustics, Abstracta has embraced the growing interest in sound absorption and more efficient working environments. Unlike visual landscapes, soundscapes can't be seen. Sound doesn't disappear when we close our eyes. The soundscapes that surround us are perpetual and affect us more than we think. Abstracta has used this as its starting point and, combined with the company's knowledge in this area, has developed products that create effective soundscapes for different office environments. Abstracta is a Swedish company with its own factory in Småland which is home to both production and development. The company has been operating since 1972.
