

Akua Objects Exhibits at 3 Days of Design in Copenhagen

Copenhagen, 2026 — Akua Objects, the Copenhagen-based glassware brand founded in 2022 by designer Annika Zobel Agerled and CEO Josefine Arthur, will present a curated selection of its poetic designs at this year's *3 Days of Design*.

The exhibition offers an immersive experience into the brand's artistic vision, showcasing sculptural pieces inspired by nature, vases honoring Danish poetry, floral chandeliers, and playful glassware that evokes meaningful moments.

For collectors and design enthusiasts, Akua Objects will introduce The Clara Collection - its third fine table art series, featuring unique artworks designed to be enjoyed at the table or admired as sculptural expressions of light and color throughout the home. The exhibition also features a collaboration with chef Frederik Bille Brahe, highlighting the synergy between food and design and a shared passion for glass, grapes, history, and stories that connect us.

Founded with a vision to create glassware as poetic objects, Akua Objects blends thoughtful design with traditional craftsmanship. Each piece is crafted in collaboration with master glassmakers in Murano and Bohemia, balancing artistry and utility, and reflecting the brand's commitment to timeless creations. Guided by Annika's creative vision, the forms and colors of Akua's pieces evoke warmth, nostalgia, and an emotional connection between people and the rituals they share.

The exhibition, located in central Copenhagen, is presented as a poetic tablescape within a museum-like setting, inviting visitors to explore Akua Objects' world, where every glass, vase, and bowl becomes a canvas for shared memories and stories.
