Lars Vejen Marks 30 Years of Practice with Exhibitions in Denmark and Japan

Design Studio Lars Vejen presents a special exhibition celebrating 30 years of architectural and design practice. Taking place in 2026, the exhibition reflects on past work while presenting current projects and future directions.

Based between Denmark and Japan, Lars Vejen operates across a broad range of design disciplines, including furniture, urban elements, lighting, building components and home accessories. In recognition of his contribution to the field, he was named Designer of the Year at the Design Awards 2018 by Bo Bedre and its associated publications. His work is developed in close collaboration with traditional craftsmen and established manufacturing industries, reflecting a commitment to both heritage and innovation.

The exhibition brings together a wide selection of works, presented through physical objects and digital installations. It also serves as a platform to engage with professional partners, media and clients who have contributed to the studio's development over the past three decades.

Hosted at the Rhanders flagship store, the setting underscores a shared dedication to Danish craftsmanship and manufacturing traditions spanning more than 800 years. Lars Vejen's ongoing collaboration with Rhanders forms a natural context for the exhibition.

New designs created for [Hirata Gen Collection](#), [Silkeborg Uldspinderi](#), [LK Lighting](#) and [Søuld](#) will be unveiled as part of the exhibition.

Lars Vejen's work is characterised by a strong dedication to people, human interaction and architectural context, where form, function and enduring quality remain fundamental. His practice continues to explore design that is relevant today, with the ambition to endure as the classics of tomorrow.

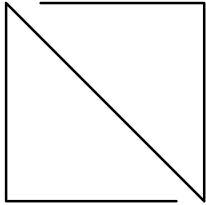
