Garde Hvalsøe is a design house rooted in Danish cabinetmaking. Since 1990, it has created kitchens and interiors in close dialogue with architecture, shaping spaces through proportion, construction and material rather than decoration.

Each project begins with observation: of a specific space, a specific architecture, a specific life. From that understanding, form emerges. Some interiors grow from the established Garde Hvalsøe design language. Others are developed specifically for their context. What remains constant is the craft foundation and more than three decades of experience at the intersection of design and making.

Design and production remain closely connected, both carried out in Denmark by skilled cabinetmakers who understand that craft is not applied at the end of a process. It is the process itself.

Natural materials, among them wood, stone and metal, are selected for their character and their capacity to change with time. The work is guided not by novelty, but by lasting relevance. Interiors are built to remain.
