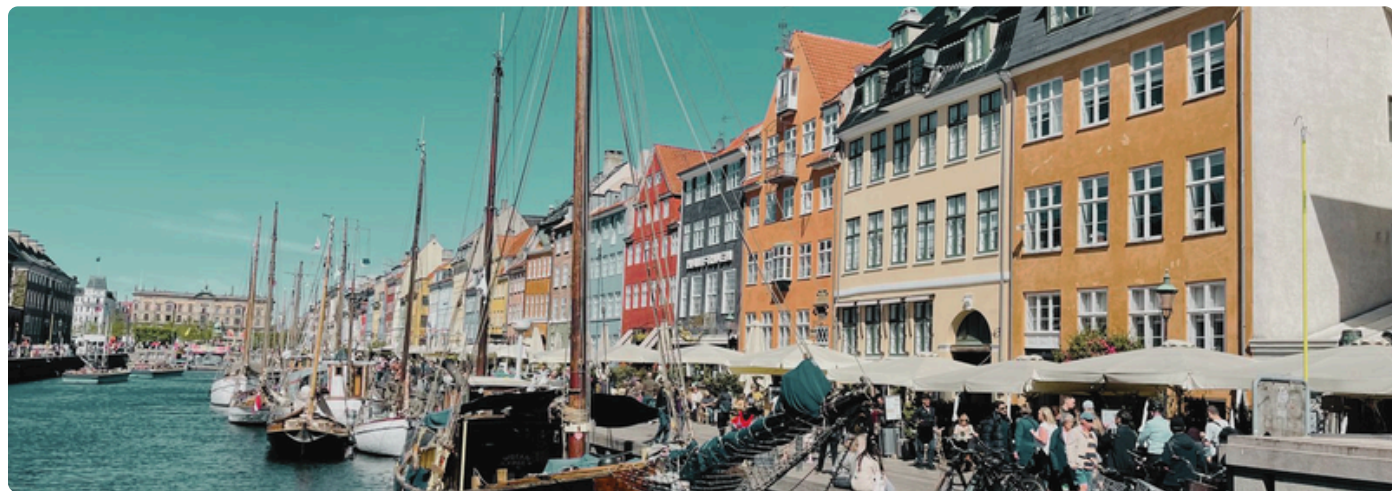
Design in Transit - Now Docked

3days**of**design



From Southeast Asia to France, and now to Copenhagen, Hévéa House continues a journey shaped by cultures, materials and time. Furniture becomes a vessel — carrying craftsmanship, memory and continuity.

At 3daysofdesign, this movement finds its pause.



Set within a former FIAT factory near the waterfront, the installation explores the moment where movement comes to rest. A place shaped by production and passage is reinterpreted as a quiet interior — where transit turns into presence.

The exhibition unfolds as a spatial composition in a docked state.

Furniture is no longer seen as isolated objects, but as vessels carrying memory, use and time.

The Bateau Desk expresses a sculptural language of movement and balance, echoing the dialogue between land and sea.

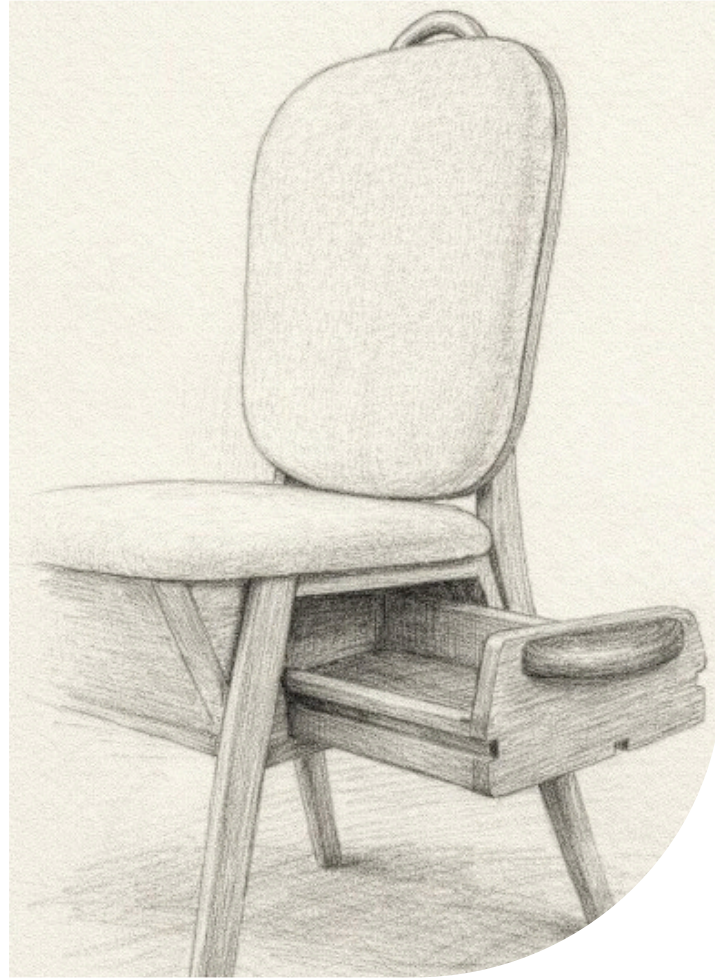
