Craft meets nature at 3daysofdesign

Galleri Sonja presents CONNECTED | A DIALOGUE BETWEEN NATURE & CRAFT during the Danish design festival 3daysofdesign in Copenhagen, Denmark, June 10–12.

Galleri Sonja - travels from the island of Bornholm to the capital to take part in 3 Days of Design. For this year's festival in Copenhagen, Galleri Sonja presents a new exhibition that celebrates the intimate relationship between craft and the natural world.

The exhibition brings together artists and designers whose practices are guided by material sensitivity and the slow processes of handcraft. For artists like Sara Martinsen, Von Linné Studio, Mette Skjærbæk, Straft, Cille Grosell and Kawabi, nature is both collaborator and muse. Bringing together artists working in this way, the exhibition *Seed: Craft and Nature* reflects a shared approach to making, where form takes shape through attention, place and time. Nature is both collaborator and muse. Colors, fibers, clay, botanicals, and organic forms are gathered, shaped, and translated into works that reflect care, creativity, and place. The exhibition highlights this exchange between maker and material, land and craft—revealing how artistic expression grows from the simple act of paying attention to the world around us.

Made by hand, filled with heart. The exhibition invites visitors to reconnect with slowness, craft, and the origins of materials—reminding us that every finished piece starts with a seed. A daily tea ceremony by Tystte adds a sensory dimension to the exhibition, creating a space to pause and engage
