Widely recognised as the first brand to launch a dedicated global collection of concrete bathroom basins, Kast is revered for its mastery of colour, achieving subtlety, precision, and depth across its expertly curated 28-signature palette.

This year, the brand expands its spectrum with three new tones, **Espresso, Oat, and Olive**, promising visitors a rich celebration of colour and an immersive, tactile experience. Espresso is a deep, grounding brown inspired by dark timber and shadowed landscapes. Oat evokes sun-bleached stone and weathered dunes, a soft, mineral hue that plays beautifully with light and texture. Olive draws from muted woodland greens and lichen-covered stone, introducing a subtle organic warmth that harmonises with natural materials.

On display will be Kast's award-winning **Orme pedestal basin**, alongside 28 miniature **Tilde** basins from the Wave collection, each presented in one of Kast's signature colours. Visitors will be able to take in the full spectrum, experiencing a true colour explosion that transforms concrete into a playful, tactile canvas.

Based in Nottinghamshire, UK, Kast has been handcrafting concrete basins for over 20 years and became part of **Kohler Co.** in 2023. Each piece is made from aggregate-based concrete using local Derbyshire limestone, selected sands, and high-quality pigments, producing velvety finishes that highlight both sculptural form and tonal depth.

Kast will be part of **Material Matters Copenhagen** at **Gammel Dok, Strandgade 27B, 1401 København**, from **10–12 June 2026**, inviting visitors to explore its expanded palette and experience colour-led concrete design at its most expressive.
