DK: Layers of Light åbner sit første showroom under 3daysofdesign: En fusion af kunst og lysteknisk præcision

KØBENHAVN, JUNI 2026

Under dette års 3daysofdesign slår belysningsbrandet Layers of Light for første gang dørene op til sit eget showroom. Udstillingen er placeret i en uforstyrret fløj af det historiske Odd Fellow Palæ og markerer en vigtig milepæl for brandet, der præsenterer både signatur-væglamper og en ny kollektion af fritstående skulpturer.

Mere end belysning

Layers of Light er skabt ud fra visionen om, at lys skal føles ligeså meget, som det ses. Ved at forene præcis lysteknik med en kunstnerisk tilgang skaber brandet skulpturelle objekter, der forvandler væggen til en komposition af dybde, skygge og refleksion.

"Vores arbejde er en hyldest til kærligheden for lyset. Vi designer ikke bare lamper; vi designer atmosfærer, der skaber samtale," fortæller Bettina Elbæk Pedersen, stifter af Layers of Light. "At flytte ind i vores første showroom i hjertet af København giver os muligheden for at vise den fulde sanselige oplevelse af et 'Light Less Ordinary'."





Bæredygtighed med genbrugsmaterialer

Et højdepunkt på udstillingen er afsløringen af nye fritstående skulpturelle lamper. Som en undersøgelse af bæredygtigt håndværk er disse værker skabt af genbrugte byggematerialer, hvilket giver nyt liv til glemte teksturer, mens brandets æstetiske og tekniske niveau bevares.

Om Layers of Light

Layers of Light blev grundlagt i 2023 af Bettina Elbæk Pedersen. Med sin omfattende erfaring fra belysningsbranchen, herunder som mangeårig Design Director hos Louis Poulsen, bringer hun en dyb forståelse for lysets funktionelle og emotionelle betydning ind i sit eget designunivers. Studiet specialiserer sig i skulpturel belysning, der bygger bro mellem teknik og kunst.

During this year's 3daysofdesign, the lighting brand Layers of Light officially opens the doors to its first-ever showroom. Located in a secluded wing of the historic Odd Fellow Palace, the exhibition marks a significant milestone for the brand, showcasing its signature wall-mounted pieces alongside a new collection of sculptural lamps.

Beyond Illumination

Layers of Light was founded on the principle that light should be felt as much as seen. By merging precise engineering with an artistic approach, the brand creates sculptural objects that transform walls into deep compositions of shadow and reflection.

"Our work is a tribute to the love of light. We don't just design lamps; we design atmospheres that spark conversations," says Bettina Elbæk Pedersen, Founder of Layers of Light. "Moving into our first showroom in the heart of Copenhagen allows us to show the full sensory impact of our 'Light Less Ordinary'."



Sustainability Through Reclaimed Materials

A highlight of the exhibition is the unveiling of new, free-standing sculptural pieces. In an exploration of sustainable craftsmanship, these lamps are crafted from reclaimed building materials, giving new life to forgotten textures while maintaining the brand's aesthetic and technical rigor.

Layers of Light was founded in 2023 by Bettina Elbæk Pedersen. Drawing on her extensive experience in the lighting industry, including her long tenure as Design Director at Louis Poulsen, she brings a deep understanding of light's functional and emotional impact.
