The Moment is NAU

At 3daysofdesign 2026, Australian design brand NAU will present **The Moment is NAU**, an exhibition and program of conversations exploring contemporary Australian design within the global design landscape.

Presented in Copenhagen during the festival, the exhibition introduces NAU's collection of furniture and lighting created in collaboration with leading Australian designers. Characterised by sculptural form, honest materials and refined craftsmanship, the works reflect a distinctly southern design perspective shaped by landscape, culture and a relaxed approach to contemporary living.

Alongside the exhibition, NAU will host a panel discussion exploring the relationship between design legacy and contemporary practice. The conversation will examine how designers today navigate the tension between tradition and innovation, balancing enduring principles of craft, longevity and material integrity with the evolving cultural and environmental context of the present. Australian designer Adam Goodrum will be present during the festival, contributing to the dialogue and representing the next generation of Australian design on the international stage.

To extend the experience beyond the installation, a small printed editorial publication will accompany the exhibition. Designed as a fold-out A5 piece, the publication includes interviews with NAU founder Richard Munao and Adam Goodrum, alongside reflections on contemporary Australian design and insights into the ideas shaping the brand today.

During the festival, Cult will also host NAU, Later, an Australian design gathering bringing together international media, designers and industry partners. The event celebrates the social and cultural side of design, creating a relaxed environment for conversation and connection while reflecting the openness and hospitality often associated with Australian design culture.

Together, the exhibition and events position NAU as a confident contemporary design voice while reinforcing Cult's role as a connector between Australian design and the international design community.
